



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 59" [127 x 150 cm], excluding tassels.

GAUGES

18 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Moss St Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Moss St Pat worked over foundation chain multiple of 2. *See Diagram on page 2.*

Stripe Pat

With C, work 4 rows.

With A, work 4 rows.

These 8 rows form Stripe Pat.

BLANKET

With A, ch 224.

Set-Up: 1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc). *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from * to end of row. 223 sts (including sc and ch-1 sts).

Proceed in Moss St Pat as follows:
2nd row: Ch 2 (counts as 1 sc. Ch 1). Skip first sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last sc. Turn.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Lattice™ (7.8 oz/220 g; 389 yds/356 m)

Contrast A Rose Mix (19001) **3 balls or 1050 yds/956 m**

Contrast B Cherry (19006) **2 balls or 510 yds/464 m**

Contrast C Cream (19013) **4 balls or 1320 yds/1201 m**

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. 7" [18 cm] piece of cardboard for tassels.

Rep 2nd row twice more, ending on a WS row. Join B. Break A.

With B, rep 2nd row for Moss St Pat for 6" [15 cm], ending on a WS row. Join C. Break B.

Note: When working Stripe Pat, **do not** cut yarn. Carry color not in use loosely up side of work.

With C, cont in Moss St Pat, AT SAME TIME, proceed in Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx 52" [132 cm], ending with 4 rows of C. Join B. Break C.

With B, work in Moss St Pat for 6" [15 cm], ending on a WS row. Join A. Break B.
With A, work 4 rows in Moss St Pat. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Right-Side Edging: (RS). Join A with sl st to bottom right corner of Blanket. Ch 1. Work sc evenly along side of Blanket, changing to B to match side edge, then working with C only along Striped section. Work around yarn carried up side of work to enclose it, changing colors at opposite end as before to match side of Blanket.

Fasten off.

Left-Side Edging: Work as for Right-Side Edging along Left-Side of Blanket.

Tassels (make 18): Wrap C around a 7" [18 cm] piece of cardboard 30 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across other end. Wrap C 6 times around tassel 1½" [4 cm] from tied end and fasten securely. Attach Tassel at each corner of Blanket. Attach 7 Tassels evenly spaced across short edges of Blanket.
