



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>Approx</b> =	<b>Pat</b> = Pattern	<b>Sl st</b> = Slip stitch
Approximately	<b>Rem</b> = Remain(ing)	<b>Sp(s)</b> = Space(s)
<b>Beg</b> = Begin(ning)	<b>Rep</b> = Repeat	<b>St(s)</b> = Stitch(es)

## MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (Approx) 50½" [128.5 cm] x 64" [162.5 cm].

## GAUGE

7 single crochet (sc) and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Carry yarn A loosely up side of work when not in use.

### Stripe Pattern (Pat)

With A, work 4 rows. Join B.  
With B, work 4 rows. Break B.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join C.  
With C, work 8 rows. Break C.

With A, work 4 rows. Join D.  
With D, work 4 rows. Break D.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join E.  
With E, work 8 rows. Break E.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join F.  
With F, work 4 rows. Break F.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join B.  
With B, work 8 rows. Break B.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join C.  
With C, work 4 rows. Break C.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join D.  
With D, work 8 rows. Break D.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join E.  
With E, work 4 rows. Break E.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join F.  
With F, work 8 rows. Break F.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join B.  
With B, work 4 rows. Break B.  
With A, work 4 rows. Join C.  
With C, work 8 rows. Break C.  
With A, work 4 rows.  
These 124 rows form Stripe Pat.

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

<b>Contrast A</b> Vintage White (10006)	<b>3 balls or 616 yds/563.5 m</b>
<b>Contrast B</b> Tan Pink (10898)	<b>1 ball or 197 yds/180 m</b>
<b>Contrast C</b> Terracotta Rose (10880)	<b>2 balls or 275 yds/252 m</b>
<b>Contrast D</b> Sunsoaked (10918)	<b>1 ball or 130 yds/118.5 m</b>
<b>Contrast E</b> Aquatic (10801)	<b>1 ball or 193 yds/177 m</b>
<b>Contrast F</b> Country Blue (10106)	<b>1 ball or 172 yds/157.5 m</b>

Size U.S. N/15 (10 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.

## BLANKET

With A, chain (ch) 94.

**1st row:** [Right side (RS)]. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 12 ch. \*(Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 3 times. Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc. Repeat (rep) from \* to end of chain. Turn. (77 sc and 16 ch-1 sps).

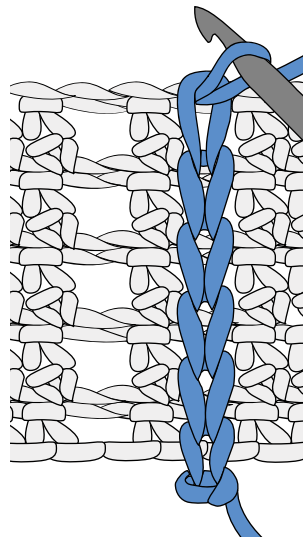
**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 13 sc. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 space (sp). (1 sc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp) 3 times. \*1 sc in each of next 13 sc. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. (1 sc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp) 3 times. Rep from \* twice more. 1 sc in each of last 13 sc. Turn. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat complete.

Keeping continuity (cont) of Stripe Pat, rep 2nd row until Stripe Pat is complete, ending on a wrong side (WS) row. Fasten off.

## Surface Chain stitches (sts):

**1st vertical row:** With RS of Blanket facing, begin (beg) at bottom left edge, join Color with slip stitch (sl st) to first ch-1 sp of foundation row. Pull loop to maintain length of first row. Working vertically, insert hook in corresponding ch-1 sp of next row. Yarn over hook (yoh) and draw up a loop – first ch made. Work in chains to last row of Blanket. Fasten off.

Rep for remaining (rem) vertical ch-1 sp rows, changing Color in the following sequence: (F – 4 rows. B – 4 rows. C – 4 rows. E – 4 rows) as shown in photo.



## FINISHING

**Blocking:** Pin Blanket on a flat surface to measurements - 48½" [123 cm] x 62" [157.5 cm]. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

**Edging: 1st rnd:** (RS). Join A with sl st to top right corner. Ch 1. Work in sc evenly around having (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in corners, being sure to work around yarn carried up side of work. Join with sl st to first sc.

**Note:** For even edging, top and bottom edges should have approx 89 sc across and each side edge should have approx 108 sc across, adjusting as necessary to create even edges.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around, working (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in each corner ch-1 sp. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
