

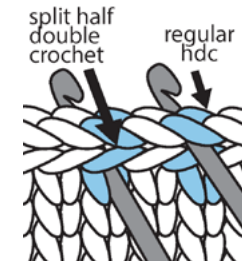


CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately  
**Beg** = Begin(ning)  
**Ch** = Chain(s)  
**Hdc** = Half double crochet  
**Rep** = Repeat  
**RS** = Right side  
**Splhdc** = Split half double crochet: work hdc between 'legs' at front and back of stitch (splitting stitch) instead of through top loops. Stitches should appear as "V"s on RS and WS of work.

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)  
**WS** = Wrong side



SPLIT HALF DOUBLE CROCHET

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)  
**Main Color MC** Vintage White (10006) **3 balls or 600 yds/545 m**  
**Contrast A** Aquatic (10801) **2 balls or 315 yds/287 m**  
**Contrast B** Lapis (10800) **2 balls or 290 yds/264 m**  
 Size U.S. P/17 (15 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
 Susan Bates® yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 46" x 57" [117 x 144.5 cm].

## GAUGE

5.5 splhdc and 6 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Work color changes using intarsia technique. Use separate balls of yarn for each area of color in the design.
- When joining colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color. Pick up new color under old color at WS of work to lock colors in and avoid a hole. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed in new color, leaving old color at WS of work.
- Each square on chart represents 1 stitch.

## BLANKET

With MC, ch 64.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 63 hdc.

First row of chart is complete.

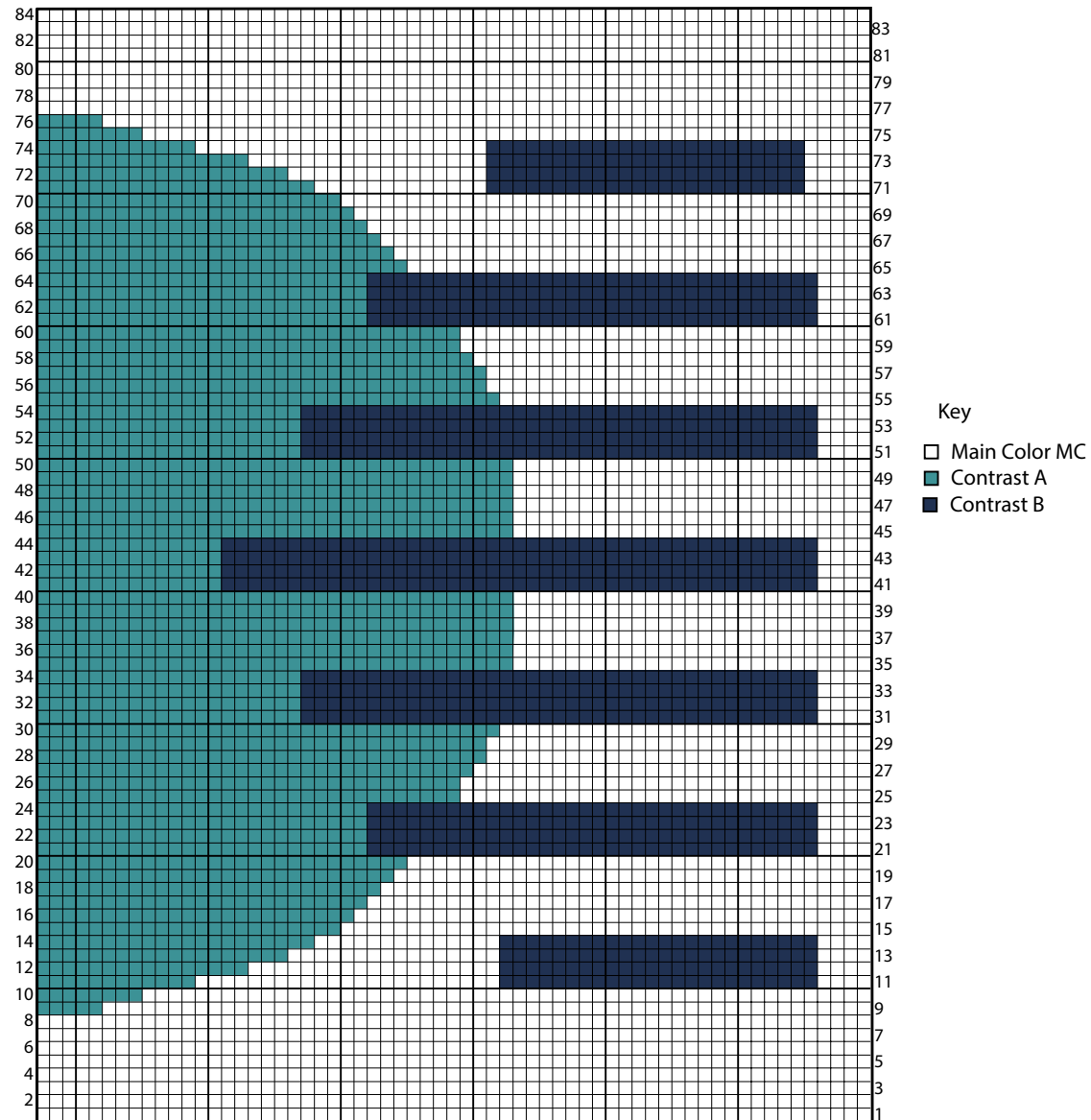
Work in Chart to end of chart, reading RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right as follows:

**2nd row:** Ch 1. Work 2nd row of Chart, 1 splhdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Cont in Chart, rep last row until 84 rows of Chart are complete.

Fasten off.
