Bernat ${ }^{\otimes}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Main Color MC Vintage White (10006) $\mathbf{3}$ balls or $\mathbf{6 0 0} \mathbf{~ y d s / 5 4 5 ~ m ~}$
Contrast A Aquatic (10801)
Contrast B Lapis (10800) 2 balls or $\mathbf{3 1 5} \mathrm{yds} / \mathbf{2 8 7} \mathrm{m}$ 2 balls or $\mathbf{2 9 0}$ yds/264 m Size U.S. P/17 ( 15 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
St(s) = Stitch(es)

Beg $=$ Begin(ning)
WS = Wrong side
Ch = Chain(s)
Hdc = Half double crochet
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS = Right side
Splhdc = Split half double crochet: work hdc between 'legs' at front and back of stitch (splitting stitch) instead of through top loops. Stitches should appear as "V"s on RS and WS of work.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 46 " x 57" [ $117 \times 144.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## GAUGE

5.5 splhdc and 6 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

- Work color changes using intarsia technique. Use separate balls of yarn for each area of color in the design.

## BLANKET

With MC, ch 64.
1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 63 hdc.
First row of chart is complete.
Work in Chart to end of chart, reading RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right as follows:
2nd row: Ch 1. Work 2nd row of Chart, 1 splhdc in each st to end of row. Turn.
Cont in Chart, rep last row until 84 rows of Chart are complete. Fasten off.
