

## MEASUREMENTS

To fit round basket approx 18 " $[45.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ diameter x 16 " $[40.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ tall.

## MATERIALS

Bernat Handicrafter ${ }^{\circ}$ Cotton
$400 \mathrm{~g} / 14$ oz; $650 \mathrm{~m} / 710$ yds OR $42.5 \mathrm{~g} / 1.5$ oz; $62 \mathrm{~m} / 68 \mathrm{yds}$
Requires: $615 \mathrm{~m} / 673 \mathrm{yds}$
OR 400 g ball: 1 ball
OR 42.5 g ball: $\mathbf{1 0}$ balls
Size 5.5 mm (U.S. I or 9) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

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## INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Ch 2 at beg of rnd does not count as st throughout. Join all rnds with sl st in first st.

Beg at bottom, ch 5 . Join with sl st to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 2.8 hdc in ring. Join. 8 hdc.
2nd rnd: Ch 2.2 hdc in each hdc around. Join. 16 hdc.
3rd rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 hdc.
4th rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 32 hdc.

5th rnd: Ch 2. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc . Rep from * around. Join. 40 hdc.

Cont inc 8 sts every rnd evenly spaced (as before) until there are 168 hdc (approx 18 " [ 45.5 cm ] diameter).

Next rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). Working in front loops only, 1 dc in each hdc around. Join. Place marker.
Next rnd: Ch 1 . Working in both loops, 1 sc in each dc around. Join.
Next rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each sc around. Join.
Rep last 2 rnds until work from marker measures $16^{" ~[~} 40.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending with sc rnd.

Next rnd: (Openings for handles). Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in next sc. Ch 25 . Miss next 24 sc .1 dc in each of next 60 sc . Ch 25 . Miss next 24 sc . 1 dc in each sc to end of rnd. Join.
Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each st (working 1 sc in each ch) around. 170 sc . Join.

Proceed in Lace Pat as follows:
1st rnd. Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. *Ch 1. Miss next sc. 1 sc in next sc . Miss next 3 sc . ( 3 dc . Ch 1.3 dc ) in next sc - shell made. Miss next 3 sc . 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around; ending with 1 sc in next sc. Ch 1 . Miss last sc. Join.
2nd rnd: SI st in next ch-1 sp. Ch 3 (counts as hdc and ch 1). 1 hdc in same sp. *Ch 3.1 sc in top of next Shell. Ch 3. (1 hdc. Ch 1.1 hdc) in next ch-1 sp-v-st made. Rep from * around. Join to 2 nd ch of ch 3.
3rd rnd: SI st in first ch-1 sp. Ch 3 . ( 2 dc . Ch 1.3 dc ) in same sp. * 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1 . Miss next sc. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Shell in next V-st. Rep from * around; ending with 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Join to top of ch 3 .
4th rnd: SI st in each of next 2 dc and ch-1 sp. Ch 1.1 sc in same sp. *Ch 3. V-st in next ch-1 sp. Ch 3.1 sc in top of next Shell. Rep from * around. Join to first sc.
5th rnd: SI st back in last ch-3 sp. Ch 1.1 sc in same sp. *Ch 1. Miss next sc .1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Shell in next $V$-st. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * around; ending with Shell in last V-st. Join to first sc. Rep 2nd to 5th rnds for 4 " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$, ending with 3rd or 5th rnd. Fasten off.

Ties (make 8). Ch 15. SI st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Fasten off. Sew 2 ties at each side of openings (see photo).
