Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Plush $^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $8.8 \mathrm{oz} / 250 \mathrm{~g} ; 146 \mathrm{yds} / 133 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Deep Woods (68025) $\mathbf{3}$ balls or 405 yds/370 m Contrast B Spruce (68027) 1 ball or 82 yds/75.5 m
Size U.S. M/13 (9 mm) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ stitch marker. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 14" [ 35.5 cm ] diameter x $91 / 2$ " [24.5 cm ] high.

## GAUGES

7 sc and 9 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.

With A, ch 2.
1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join.
2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc .
4th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 32 sc .

5th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 40 sc .
6th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 48 sc .
7th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 56 sc .
8th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 64 sc .
Cont in this manner, inc 8 sc evenly around next 5 rnds (as established). 104 sc .

Next rnd: Ch 1. Working into back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Place marker at end of rnd.
Next rnd: Ch 1. Working into both loops, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

Rep last rnd until work from marked rnd measures 8 " [ 20.5 cm ]. Join $B$ at end of last rnd. With B , rep last rnd twice more. Do not fasten off.

## Next rnd (Handle openings):

Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 21 sc . Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Ch 1 . Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 42 sc. Ch 1 . Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc . Ch 1 . Skip next sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join.
Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc and ch-1 sp around. Join
Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off.

Handles: With B, ch 26. Thread chain through first ch-1 sp of Handle opening rnd and back out through second ch-1 sp of same rnd. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring, being careful not to twist.
Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each ch around, rotating chain through Handle opening for ease of working. Join. Fasten off. Rep for second Handle.
