

## MATERIALS

Bernat $^{\oplus}$ Baby Blanket Calico ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Driftwood Dreams (04924) 2 balls or 376 yds/344 m
Contrast B Ocean Waves (04932)
2 balls or 376 yds/344 m
Size U.S. M/13 (9 mm) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ stitch marker. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning Ch = Chain(s)
Cont $=$ Continue(ity)
Inc = Increase(ing)

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 14" [ 35.5 cm ] diameter x $91 / 2$ " [24.5 cm ] high.

## GAUGE

7 sc and 7 rows $=4$ " [10 cm ] with
2 strands of yarn held tog.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Join all rnds with sl st to first sc

## BASKET

Beg at Base, with 1 strand each of $A$ and $B$ held tog, ch 2.
1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join.
2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc .

Rnd(s) = Round(s)
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
SI st(s) = Slip stitch(es)
Sp(s) = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
3rd rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc.
4th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 32 sc .
5th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 40 sc .
6th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 48 sc .
7th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 56 sc .
8th rnd: Ch 1. ${ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 64 sc .
Cont in this manner, inc 8 sc evenly around next 5 rnds (as established). 104 sc.

Next rnd: Ch 1. Working into back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Place marker at end of rnd.
Next rnd: Ch 1. Working into both loops, 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Rep last rnd until work from marked rnd measures 9 " [ 23 cm ].

## Next rnd (Handle openings):

 Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 21 sc . Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Ch 1 . Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 42 sc . Ch 1 . Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc . Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join.Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc and ch-1 sp around. Join.
Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off.

Handles: With 1 strand each of A and $B$ held tog, ch 26. Thread chain through first ch-1 sp of Handle opening rnd and back out through second ch-1 sp of same rnd. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring, being careful not to twist.
Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each ch around, rotating chain through Handle opening for ease of working. Join. Fasten off.
Rep for second Handle.
