#### **MATERIALS**

**Bernat® Blanket Big™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 32 yds/29 m)

Contrast A Gold (51069)

2 balls or 45 yds/41 m 1 ball or 1 yd/0.9 m

**Contrast B** Malachite (51060)

Susan Bates® jumbo yarn needle.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dc2tog** = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

**Rep** = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sc2tog** = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook/finger

# **MEASUREMENT**

Approx 12" [30.5 cm] in diameter.

# **GAUGE**

2 sc and 2 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Notes:**

- This project is made with hand crochet, no hook is needed. Use 2 fingers in the stitching/ active loops, and only 1 finger for the sl st join at the end of each round
- All rnds are joined with a sl st to first st.

**1st rnd (RS):** Ch 2. 6 sc in 2nd ch from last loop. Join. 6 sc.

around. Join. 12 sc.

in next st. Rep from \* around. Join. the 2 ends tog and tie in a knot so 18 sts.

4th rnd: Ch 1. \*1 sc in next st. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from \* around. Join.

5th rnd: As 4th rnd.

Dc2tog. Rep from \* around. Join. 12 sts.

**7th rnd:** Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. Rep from \* around, Join, 6 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a 24" [61cm] tail.

### Make Stem:

Cut 1 length of B 18" [45.5 cm] long. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc Fold in half, holding 2 strands tog of one end. Twist strands to the **3rd rnd:** Ch 1. \*1 sc in next st. 2 dc right until they being to curl. Fold they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog.

# **Assembly:**

Insert the Stem into the top hole of **6th rnd:** Ch 1. \*1 sc in next st. the pumpkin so that the cut ends are inside. Use the long tail of the pumpkin to gather the sts of the final round closed. Pull the tail through the center of the stem to secure it. Use the finishing needle to send the end through the center of the pumpkin and through the center of the 1st rnd to collapse pumpkin. Weave in end on bottom of pumpkin.
