Bernat $^{\oplus}$ Maker ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ ( 8.8 oz/250 g; 317 yds/290 m)
$\begin{array}{ll}\text { Small Version Cream (06003) } & \mathbf{1} \text { ball } \\ \text { Large Version Cream (06003) } & \mathbf{1} \text { ball }\end{array}$
Size U.S. 7 ( 4.5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\otimes}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ stitch marker. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)
Beg $=$ Begin(ning)
Beglnkdc = Insert hook down through horizontal bar in center of previous stitch, yoh and pull up a loop. Insert hook into ring, yoh and pull up a loop. Yoh and pull through first 2 loops on hook. Yoh and pull through last 2 loops on hook-Beginning Linked Dc made. $\mathbf{C h}=$ Chain(s)
Dc = Double crochet
Hdc = Half double crochet

## MEASUREMENTS

Small Version:
Approx 5" [12.5 cm] diameter x 5" [12.5 cm ] tall.
Large Version:
Approx $71 / 2$ " $[19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] diameter x $81 / 2 "[21.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ tall.

Lnkdc = Insert hook down through the horizontal bar in the center of previous stitch, yoh and pull up a loop. Insert hook in indicated space or stitch and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through first 2 loops on hook. Yoh and pull through rem 2
loops on hook Linked Dc made.


Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS = Right side
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
$\mathbf{S I} \mathbf{s t}=$ Slip stitch
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## GAUGE

16 Inkdc and 8 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.

Notes: Rnds are worked as a spiral. First Inkdc of each rnd is worked into last Inkdc of previous rnd.

Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.
Set-up rnd: (2 sc. 1 hdc. 1 dc. Place marker in dc. 8 beglnkdc) in ring. 1 Inkdc in each st to marker. 12 sts.
1st rnd: (RS). Beg in last dc from previous rnd, work 2 Inkdc in each st around. 24 Inkdc.
2nd rnd: *1 Inkdc in next Inkdc. 2 Inkdc in next Inkdc. Rep from * around. 36 Inkdc.
3rd rnd: *1 Inkdc in each of next 2 Inkdc. 2 Inkdc in next Inkdc. Rep from * around. 48 Inkdc.
4th rnd: *1 Inkdc in each of next 3 Inkdc. 2 Inkdc in next Inkdc. Rep from * around. 60 Inkdc.

## Large Version only: 5th rnd:

*1 Inkdc in each of next 4 Inkdc. 2 Inkdc in next Inkdc. Rep from * around. 72 Inkdc.
6th rnd: * 1 Inkdc in each of next 5 Inkdc. 2 Inkdc in next Inkdc. Rep from * around. 84 Inkdc.

Both sizes: Next rnd: 1 Inkdc in each Inkdc around.
Rep last rnd until work from beg measures 4 (7)" [10(18) cm].

Next rnd: 1 Inkdc in each Inkdc to last 3 sts. 1 hdc in next Inkdc. 1 sc in each of next 2 Inkdc. Join with sl st to first st in rnd.

Cuff: Turn work so WS is facing.
1st row: (WS). Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 dc in next st. Place marker in dc. Working in back loops only, 1 Inkdc in each st to marker.
2nd row: 1 Inkdc in each Inkdc around.
Rep 2nd row 1 (3) time(s) more.
Next rnd: 1 Inkdc in each Inkdc to last 3 sts. 1 hdc in next Inkdc. 1 sc in each of next 2 Inkdc. Join with sl st to first st in rnd. Fasten off.
