



## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket Extra™** (300 g/10.5 oz; 97 yds/87 m)

**Contrast A** Vintage White (27042) **2 balls**

**Contrast B** Almond (27032) **1 ball**

**Contrast C** Light Teal (27037) **1 ball**

Size U.S. Q (15 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Wooden dowel 30" [76 cm] long, ¾" [2 cm] diameter.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =

Approximately

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rem** = Remaining

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 27" [68.5 cm] wide x 48" [122 cm] long, including fringe

## GAUGE

4 sc and 4 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** When joining new color, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed.

With A, ch 28. See chart on page 2.

**1st Foundation row:** (RS). 1 dc in 6th ch from hook (counts as dc, ch 1 and dc). \*Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 dc in next ch. Rep from \* to end of chain. Turn.

**2nd Foundation row:** Ch 1. Working in **front loops only**, 1 sc in each st to end of row. Join B. Turn. 25 sc.

Proceed in pat as follows (See chart on page 2):

**1st row:** (RS). With B, ch 1. Working in **back loops only**, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**2nd row:** 1 sl st in each sc to end of row. Join A. Turn.

**3rd row:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each sl st to end of row. Turn.

**4th row:** As 2nd row. Join B. Turn.

**5th row:** With B, as 3rd row.

**6th to 21st rows:** Rep 2nd to 5th rows 4 times more. Break A.

**22nd row:** (WS). With B, as 2nd row. Join C.

**23rd and 24th rows:** With C, as 3rd and 2nd rows. Break C.

**25th and 26th rows:** With B, as 3rd and 2nd rows. Join A. Break B.

**27th row:** (RS). With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each sl st to end of row. Turn.

**28th row:** Ch 1. Working in *front loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**29th row:** Ch 1. Working in *both loops*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**30th and 31st rows:** Rep last 2 rows once more. **Do not** fasten off.

**Note:** Twisted Fringe Rows worked across last row and rem loops of 27th and 29th rows. 3 rows of fringe in A in total.

**Twisted Fringe Row:** \*\*With A, ch 1. \*Draw up a loop 10" [25.5 cm] long. Twist loop 30 times. Sl st in same st, allowing twisted loop to coil around itself. Sl st in next sc. Rep from \* to end of row. Fasten off. \*\*

With RS facing, join A with sl st to rem loop of first st of 29th row. Rep from \*\* to \*\*. Rep for 27th row.

## Short Sections of 5 Twisted Fringes:

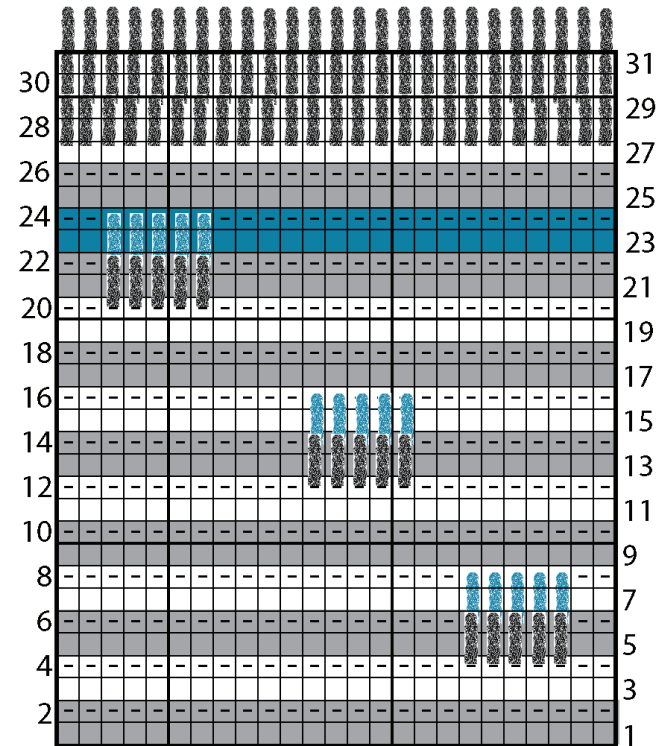
**First Section:** Following chart, join A with sl st to 3rd st of 4th row. Work 5 fringes as before. Following chart, join B with sl st to 3rd st of 6th row. Work 5 fringes as before.

**Second Section:** Following chart, join A with sl st to 10th st of 14th row. Work 5 fringes as before. Following chart, join B with sl st to 10th st of 16th row. Work 5 fringes as before.



**Third Section:** Following chart, join A with sl st to 19th st of 22nd row. Work 5 fringes as before. Following chart, join A with sl st to 19th st of 24th row. Work 5 fringes as before.

## FINISHING

Thread dowel through 1st Foundation row (dc row).
