## **MEASUREMENTS**

**Beet:** Approx 3½" [9 cm] diameter; 4½" [16.5 cm] root long excluding leaves; 8" [20.5 cm] long leaves. **Small Pumpkin:** Approx 5" [12.5 cm] diameter; 3" [7.5 cm] tall excluding stem.

**Large Pumpkin:** Approx 6½" [16.5 cm] diameter; 3½" [9 cm] tall excluding stem.

Small Butternut Squash: Approx 2½" [6 cm] diameter; 5" [12.5 cm] long excluding stem. Large Butternut Squash: Approx 3" 7.5 cm] diameter; 6½" [16.5 cm] long excluding stem.

8 sc and 9 rows = 4" [10 cm].

**Note:** Join all rnds with sl st in first sc.

## With C, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as last sl st. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp aslastslst.\*1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. 18 sc. Join F with sl st to first sc. Break C.

**4th rnd:** With F, ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as last sl st. \*1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to last 2 sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Join. 24 sc.

**5th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as last sl st. \*1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to last 3 sc. 1 sc in each of last 3 sc. Join. 30 sc.

7th and 8th rnds: As 5th rnd.
9th rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Rep from \* 4 times more. Join. 25 sc.
10th rnd: As 5th rnd.
11th rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from \* 4 times more. Join. 20 sc.
12th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc

around. Join. **13th rnd:** Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc

in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* 4 times more. Join. 15 sts.

**14th rnd:** Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* 4 times more. Join. 10 sts.

Stuff Beet.

**15th rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog) 5 times. Join. 5 sts.

**16th to 18th rnds:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**19th rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in last sc. Join. 3 sts. Fasten off .

**Leaves** (make 3). With C, ch 26.

See diagram on page 4.

**1st rnd:** 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each of next 10 ch. Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 3 ch. 1 tr in each of next 3 ch. 1 dtr in each of next 3 ch. 1 tr in each of next 2 ch. 1 dc in next ch. 1 hdc in next ch. 3 sc in last ch. Working along opposite side of ch into rem loops, 1 hdc in next ch. 1 dc in next ch. 1 tr in each of next 2 ch. 1 dtr in each of next 3 ch. 1 tr in each of next 3 ch. 1 dc in each of next 3 ch. Ch 3. Sl st in each of last 10 ch. Fasten off, leaving a long end.

## PUMPKINS



The instructions are written for Small Pumpkin. If changes are necessary for Large Pumpkin the instructions will be written Small Pumpkin (Large Pumpkin). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.

\*\*Note: Ch 2 does not count as hdc at beg of rnd. With E (A), ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring. See diagrams on page 4. **1st rnd:** Ch 2. **8** (9) hdc in ring. Join with sl st to first hdc. **8** (9) hdc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 2. 2 hdc in first hdc. 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 16 hdc. **3rd rnd:** Ch 2. \*Puff st. 1 sc in next hdc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of first puff st. **8** (9) puff sts.

**4th rnd:** Ch 2. \*2 puff sts in next puff st. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of first puff st. **16** (**18**) puff sts.

**5th rnd:** Ch 2. \*1 puff st in next puff st. 1 sc in sp between 2 puff sts. 1 puff st in next puff st. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of first puff st. **16** (**18**) puff sts.

**6th rnd:** Ch 2. \*1 puff st in next Puff st. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of first puff st. **16** (**18**) puff sts.\*\* Rep last rnd **3** (**5**) times more. \*\*\***Next rnd:** Ch 2. \*1 puff st in next puff st. Skip next sc. 1 puff st in next puff st. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of first puff st.

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**Next rnd:** SI st in sp between first 2 puff sts. Ch 2. Puff st in same sp as last sl st. \*1 sc in next sc. Puff st in sp between next 2 puff sts. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of first puff st. 8 (9) puff sts. Next rnd: Ch 1. \*1 sc in next puff st. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc. 16 (18) sc. Stuff Squash.

Next rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) 8 (9) times. Join with sl st to first st. 8 (9) sts. Fasten off, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts. Pull tightly and fasten securely.

### Stem (make 1).

With C, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. *Working in back* loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. Working in both loops, ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

Rep last rnd 3 (4) times more. **Next rnd:** Ch 1. \*(1 hdc. 1 dc. 1 hdc) in next sc. SI st in next sc. Rep from \* 2 (3) times more. Join with sl st to sp where first st was worked. Fasten off.

## **BUTTERNUT SQUASH**



The instructions are written for Small Butternut Sauash. If changes are necessary for Large **Butternut Squash** the instructions will be written thus **Small Butternut** Squash (Large Butternut Squash). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.

Note: Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.

## With **B** (**D**), ch 2.

See diagrams on page 5. **1st rnd: 6** (7) sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 (7) sc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 (14) sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. \*1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from \* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join. 18 (21) sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc of last 2 ch. Turn. 6 (8) sts. around. Join.

**5th rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as first 2 hdc. 1 scbl in each of next sl st. \*1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc 2 sc. sl st in each of last 2 (4) sl sts. in next sc. Rep from\* to last 1 (4) sc. 1 sc in each of last 1 (4) sc. Join. 23 (26) sc.

## Next 6 (8) rnds: As 4th rnd.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. \*1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from\* to last 1 (4) sc. 1 sc in each of last 1 (4) sc. Join. **31** (**34**) sc.

### Next 5 (7) rnds: As 4th rnd.

off, leaving long end.

Next rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 (3) sc. Rep from \* to last 3 (4) sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of last 1 (2) sc. Join. 23 (27) sts. Next rnd: Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 1 sc. Rep from \* to last **2** (0) sts. 1 sc in each of last **2** (0) sc. Join. 16 (18) sts. Stuff Squash. **Next rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2toq) **8** (9) times. 1 sc in last sc. Join. 8 (9) sts. Fasten

#### **Stem:** With F, ch **7** (9). **1st row:** (RS). SI st in 2nd ch from

hook and each of next 1 (3) ch. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. 1 hdc in each

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 hdcbl in each of Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1, 1 sl st in each of first 2 (4) sl st. 1 scbl in each of next 2 sc. 1 hdcbl in each of last 2 hdc. Turn. Rep last 2 rows once more. Fold Stem lengthwise. Join foundation ch and last row with sl st. Fasten off. Sew wider side to top of Squash.


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


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
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



SMALL BUTTERNUT SQUASH
