Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Maker ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $8.8 \mathrm{oz} / 250 \mathrm{~g} ; 317 \mathrm{yds} / 290 \mathrm{~m}$ ) Clay (606002) 3 balls
Size U.S. L/11 ( 8 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. 20 " 51 cm ] square pillow form.

## (c5) BULKY CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

## Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning
Bullion = (Yoh) 12 times and draw up a loop in next stitch, pulling through 12 loops on hook making sure to pull loop up to row height. Yoh and draw through 2 rem loops on hook. Ch = Chain(s)
Lp st(s) = Loop stitch(es) (worked on WS) = Insert hook in next stitch. Wrap working yarn over top of index finger, from back to front, to form 2" [ 5 cm ] loop. Yoh and draw up a loop onto hook. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook, dropping loop off index finger to back of work (see diagram). Loop will be formed on RS of work.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 20 " 51 cm ] square.

10 sc and 11 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

Pat $=$ Pattern
Rem = Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS $=$ Right side
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
Sc = Single crochet in front loop
only of next stitch
Sl st = Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## FRONT

Ch 50.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 49 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 scin rstst. *1 sc in next st. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of rst 2 sc . ${ }^{* 1} \mathrm{sc}$ in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to last st. 1 sc in last st. Turn.
5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in rst st. *Bullion in next rem loop 3 rows below (2nd row). Skip next sc. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
6th row: Ch 1.1 sc in rst st . * 1 sc in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

7th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of rst
2 sc. *Bullion in next rem loop 3 rows below. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to last st. 1 sc in last st. Turn.
8th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of rst 2 sc . ${ }^{* 1}$ sc in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to last st. 1 sc in last st. Turn.

9th row: Ch 1.1 sc in rst st. *Bullion in next rem loop 3 rows below skipping next sc. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. Rep 6th to 9th rows for pat until work from beg measures approx $191 / 2$ " [49.5 cm ], ending on a 9th row.
Next row: (WS). Ch 1.1 sc in each st to end of row.
Fasten off.

## BACK

Ch 50.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 49 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until piece from beg measures 191⁄2" [49.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Joining Front and Back: With Back facing you and WS facing each other, holding 2 strands of yarn tog, join yarn with sl st to any corner st of Pillow. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, work Lp sts evenly around 3 sides of Pillow, having 3 Lp sts in each corner. Insert pillow form. Complete rnd of Lp sts. Join with sl st to rst Lp st. Fasten off.
