



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENT

Approx 20" [51 cm] square.

GAUGE

7 sc and 7 rows = 4" (10 cm).

INSTRUCTIONS

PILLOW – worked in 1 piece

Chain (Ch) 35.

1st row: (Right side - RS). 1 single crochet (sc) in 2nd ch from hook.

1 sc in each ch to end of chain.

Turn. 34 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. *Working into back loop only of each stitch (st)*, 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Repeat (Rep) last row until Pillow measures 40" [101.5 cm], when slightly stretched. Fasten off.

Place markers along top and bottom edges 20" [51 cm] from foundation row.

FINISHING

Fold Pillow piece in half at markers with Wrong Side (WS) facing each other. Sew bottom and top edges using matching worsted yarn. Insert pillow form. Sew side seam using matching worsted yarn.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Velvet Plus™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 78 yds/71 m)

Olive (56011)

2 balls

Size U.S. M/13 (9 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
2 stitch markers. 3 yds (2.75 m) of matching smooth worsted weight yarn for seams. 20"s [51 cm] square pillow form.
