Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {Tm }} \mathbf{O}^{\mathbf{\prime}} \mathbf{G o}^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Fired Clay (42008)
1 O'Go


Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Stuffing. Yarn needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through
2 loops on hook) twice.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 16 " $[40.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in diameter.

## GAUGE

7 hdc and 6 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.

Hdc = Half double crochet
Rep $=$ Repeat
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

- Pull tie to remove.
- If desired, separate colors by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc.
- Join all rnds with sl st to first hdc.


## 'arnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

- To achieve more precise color changes, work to last full row of one color, cut yarn and rejoin at beg of next color to avoid color changes in the middle of a row.
- Change colors by drawing new color through last 2 loops on hook and proceed with new color.

FRONT and BACK (make 2 pieces alike)
Ch 3.
1st rnd: 10 hdc in 3 rd ch from hook. Join. 10 hdc.
2nd rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next hdc. 1 hdc in same hdc as dcfp. Rep from * around. Join. 20 sts.
3rd rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next dc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 30 sts.
4th rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next dc. 1 hdc in next hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 40 sts.
5th rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next dc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 50 sts.
6th rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next dc. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 60 sts.

7th rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next dc. 1 hdc in next each of next 5 hdc . Rep from * around. Join. 8th rnd: Ch 2. ${ }^{*} 1$ dcfp around next dc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc . 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 70 sts.
9th rnd: Ch 2. ${ }^{* 1}$ dcfp around next dc. 1 hdc in next hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 80 sts.
10th rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next dc. 1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 90 sts.

11th rnd: Ch 1. *1 dcfp around next dc. 1 hdc in each of next 7 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 100 sts.

Fasten off.

## Join Front and Back:

With WS facing each other, sew Front and Back tog, stuff firmly before closing completely.
