



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdcbl = Half double crochet in back loop only

Hdchb = Work 1 hdc in horizontal bar below space normally worked, created by hdc at front of work (see diagram).

Pat = Pattern

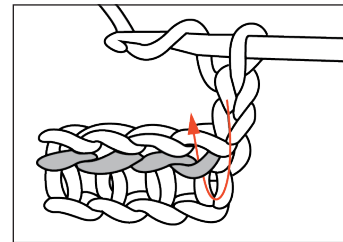
Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side



MEASUREMENT

Approx 20" [51 cm] square.

GAUGE

12 sts and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Pillow is worked in one piece with center back opening for pillow form.
- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Felted™ (9.2 oz/260 g; 249 yds/228 m)

Amber Fleck (80021)

3 balls or 545 yds/495 m

Size U.S. K/10.5 (6.5 mm) Susan Bates® Steelite® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 20" [51 cm] square pillow form.

Ch 62.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 60 hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 2. 1 hdcbl in each st to end of row. Turn

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 44" [112 cm]. Fasten off.

FINISHING

With RS tog, fold in first and last rows to overlap by 2" [5 cm] in center back to create opening to insert pillow form. Sew outer edge seams with whip stitch. Turn pillow RS out. Insert pillow form.
