BERNAT CROCHET DINO EGG RUG



MATERIALS

Bernat[®] Blanket[™] (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Main Color (MC) Light Teal (10734)4 balls or 820 yds/745 m

Bernat[®] Blanket Brights[™] (5.3 oz/150 g; 108 yds/98 m)

Contrast A Pixie Pink (13008)

1 ball or 105 yds/96 m

Sizes U.S. L/11 (8 mm) and U.S. N/15 (10 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.



🖗 CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Ch = Chain(s)
Rep = Repeat
Rem = Remaining
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet
Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook.
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 44" [112 cm] long x 31" [78.5 cm] wide.

GAUGE

6 sc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm] with 2 strands of yarn with larger hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Rug is worked with 2 strands of yarn. Dots are worked with single strand.

RUG

With 2 strands of MC and larger hook, ch 14. **1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 13 sc. With 2 strands of MC, ch 2. Join with sl st to first sc of 1st row (opposite end to working yarn). Fasten off.

2nd row: Return to working yarn. (WS). Ch 3. 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. 1 sc in next ch. 2 sc in last ch. Turn. 19 sc.

With 2 strands of MC, ch 2. Join with sl st to first sc of 2nd row (opposite to working yarn). Fasten off.

3rd row: Return to working yarn. (RS). Ch 3. 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. 1 sc in next ch. 2 sc in last ch. Turn. 25 sc.

4th to 9th rows: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 37 sc. **10th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

11th to 20th rows: As 9th and 10th rows 5 times more. 47 sc.
21st to 32nd rows: As 10th row.
33rd row: (RS). Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn.
45 sts.

34th to 36th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

37th to 48th rows: As 33rd to 36th rows 3 times more, 39 sts.

49th row: (RS). Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 37 sts.

50th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

51st to 64th rows: As 49th and 50th rows 7 times more. 23 sts. **65th to 68th rows:** Ch 1. Sc2tog.

1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 15 sts.

67th row: SI st in each of first 2 sts. Ch 1. Skip st where last sI st was made. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Fasten off. **Edging:** Join 2 strands of MC with sl st at first st of foundation ch. Ch 1. Work in sc evenly around Rug. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

DOTS

Note: Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.

Large Dot: (Make 2). **With 1 strand of A and smaller hook, ch 6.

1st rnd: 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch. 3 sc in last ch. **Do not** turn. Working across rem loops of foundation ch, 1 sc in each of next 3 ch. 1 sc in first ch. Join.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 3 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in first sc. Join.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 3 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in first sc. Join.

4th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in each of next 2 sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 3 sc in each of next 2 sc. 3 sc in next sc. 2 sc in each of next 2 sc. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc. 2 sc in each of next 9 sc. 2 sc in each of next 2 sc. 1 sc in first sc. Join.**

5th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc next sc. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. 3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc next sc. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. 1 sc in first sc. Join. **6th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Fasten off.

Small Dot: (Make 3).

Work from ** to ** as given for Large Dot. Fasten off.

Using photo as a guide, sew Dots to RS of Rug.
