

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Orange Leaf (10907) 2 balls or $\mathbf{2 8 5}$ yds/260 m
Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Value ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (7 oz/197 g; $440 \mathrm{yds} / 402 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast B Black (07421)
1 ball or 10 yds/ $\mathbf{9}$ m
Sizes U.S. J/10 ( 6 mm ) and U.S. K/10.5 ( 6.5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\oplus}$ crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle. 1 set safety eyes 12 mm diameter. Polyester fiberfil. Susan Bates ${ }^{\oplus}$ split-lock stitch markers.

## ABBREVIATIONS



## MEASUREMENT

Approx 20 " $[51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] tall.

## GAUGE

9 sc and 9 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ with Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ and larger hook.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Join with sl st to first sc at end of each rnd.

## FIRST FOOT

With A and larger hook, ch 6. See diagram on page 4.
1st rnd: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch .3 sc in last ch. Working into rem loops of ch, 1 sc in each of next 3 ch .2 sc in sp where first sc made. Join. 12 sc .

2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st .1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in each of next 3 sc . 1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in each of last 2 sc . Join. 18 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc .2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 3 sc . Join. 22 sc .
4th and 5th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
6th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . (Sc2tog) 6 times. 1 sc in each of last 6 sc. Join. 16 sts.

7th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in each of last 7 sc. Join. 14 sts.
8th and 9th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join. Place marker on 10th sc of last rnd.
Fasten off.

## SECOND FOOT

See diagram on page 4.
Work as given for First Foot, but do not fasten off at end of last rnd, and
do not place marker.
JOIN FEET: Next rnd: Ch 1. Work 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. Ch 2. Work 2 sc in marked sc of First Foot. 1 sc in each of next 12 sc of First Foot. 2 sc in last sc of First Foot. 1 sc in each ch of ch 2.2 sc in next unworked sc of Second Foot. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 34 sc . Fasten off.

## BODY

Join A with sl st to rem loop of 2nd ch worked in ch 2 at back of Feet. See diagrams on pages 4 and 5 .

1st rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each sc around, ending with last sc worked into rem loop of ch 2. Join. 36 sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 5 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 42 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 6 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 48 sc .
5th rnd: As 3rd rnd.
6th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 7 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 54 sc .
7th and 8th rnds: As 3rd rnd.
9th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 26 sc .2 sc in each of next 2 sc .1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 56 sc .
10th and 11th rnds: As 3rd rnd.
12th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 27 sc .2 sc in each of next 2 sc .1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 58 sc .
13th to 16th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
17th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 27 sc. (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 56 sts.
18th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join.

19th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 26 sc. (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 54 sts.
20th rnd: As 18th rnd.
21st rnd: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc . Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc . (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc . Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc . Sc2tog. Join. 48 sts.
22nd rnd: As 18th rnd.
Do not fasten off. Set Body aside and make Arms.

ARMS (Make 2)
With A and larger hook, ch 2.
See diagrams on pages 5 and 6.
1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join.
2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc .2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 18 sc . 4th to 7th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
8th rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc ) twice. Join 16 sts.
9th and 10th rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join.
11th rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc ) twice. Join. 14 sts. 12th to 14th rnds: As 9th rnd.

Stuff Arm very lightly.
Close top of Arm: Next row: Fold top of Arm to align sts. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, 1 sc in each sc to close top. 7 sc . Fasten off.

## JOIN ARMS TO BODY

1st rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 9 sc of Body. Align top row of Arm against next 7 sc of Body. Working through both thicknesses, 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. 1 sc in each of next 16 sc of Body. Align top row of second Arm against next 7 sc of Body. Working through both thicknesses, 1 sc in each of next 7 sc . 1 sc in each of next 9 sc . Join. 48 sc . 2nd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join.
Stuff Feet and Body.

## HEAD

See diagram on page 6.
1st rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 42 sts.
2nd and 3rd rnds: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join.
4th rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 36 sts.

5th and 6th rnds: As 2nd and 3rd rnds.
7th rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 30 sts.
8th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join.
Stuff Head as you work.
9th rnd: Ch 1. ${ }^{* S c}$ 2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 24 sts.
10th rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 18 sts.
11th rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join 12 sts.
Finish stuffing
Fasten off, leaving a length of yarn to sew top of Head.

EARS (Make 2)
With A and larger hook, ch 2.
See diagram on page 6.
1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 8 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 12 sc.
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
4th rnd: Ch 1 . (Sc2tog) 6 times. Join. 6 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a length of yarn to sew Ears to Head.

## MUZZLE

With A and larger hook, ch 20. Join. See diagram on page 6.
1st rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each ch around. Join. 20 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 4 sc . (Sc2tog) 6 times. 1 sc in each of last 4 sc. Join. 14 sts.
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join.
4th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 2 sc . (Sc2tog) 5 times. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Join. 9 sts.
5th rnd: Ch 1. (Sc3tog) 3 times. Join 2 strands of B held tog. Break A.
Bobble Nose: Holding 2 strands of B tog, ch 3. (Yoh and draw up a loop. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times all in 3rd ch from hook. Yoh and draw through 5 loops on hook. Ch 1 - Bobble Nose made. Fasten off, leaving approx 6" [15 cm ] length. Thread end through yarn needle and pull through top of 2nd Sc2tog of last Muzzle rnd to form Nose. Secure on WS.

## HAT

Top: With smaller hook and 2 strands of $B$ held tog, ch 2.
See diagram on page 6 .
1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 8 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc.
Side: 4th rnd: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.
5th rnd: Ch 1. Working in both loops, (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc ) twice. 22 sts.
6th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each st around. Join.
7th rnd: Ch 1. Working in front loops only, *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 33 sc .
8th rnd: Ch 1. Working in both loops, *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Rep from * around. Join. 44 sc . Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Note: Safety eyes cannot be moved once they are properly attached, so it's best to make sure you're happy with eye placement using stitch markers before inserting them.

Stuff Muzzle lightly. Position Muzzle at front of Head and pin in place. Mark eye placement with stitch markers. Following manufacturer's instructions, attach Safety Eyes at markers.
Sew Muzzle in position.
EARS: Run yarn through last rnd of Ear and cinch to create curved Ear shape.
Sew Ears to either side of Head as shown in photo.

Sew his little Hat into position and send him off to work!
