## MEASUREMENT

Approx 12½" [32 cm] diameter.

## GAUGES

13 sc and 14 rows $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ with Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Velvet ${ }^{T \mathrm{~m}}$.
13 sc and 14 rows $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ with Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Value ${ }^{\top \mathrm{m}}$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## PEACH

## BODY

Note: Do not join at ends of rnds unless otherwise stated. Cont working in spiral placing marker on first st of rnd for easier counting.

Beg at bottom of Body, with MC, ch 2 . See diagrams on page 5.
1st rnd: 8 sc in 2 nd ch from hook.
Do not join, cont working in spiral as follows. PM (first marker) for beg of rnd. Move marker up on rnds as work progresses.
2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 16 sc .
3rd rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc.
4th rnd: 1 sc in first sc. 2 sc in next sc. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 2 sc . 2 sc in next sc. Rep from* to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. 32 sc.

5th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Rep from* around. 40 sc.
6th rnd: 1 sc in each of first 2 sc . 2 sc in next sc. *1 sc in each of next 4 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from* to last 2 sc . 1 sc in each of last 2 sc .48 sc . 7th rnd: ${ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc .1 sc in each of next 5 sc . Rep from * around. 56 sc .

## Bottom Curve of Body

1st and alt rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.
2nd rnd: 1 sc in each of first 3 sc . 2 sc in next sc. ${ }^{* 1}$ sc in each of next 6 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from* to last 3 sc .1 sc in each of last 3 sc .64 sc .
4th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc . Rep from * around. 72 sc.
6th rnd: 1 sc in each of first 4 sc . 2 sc in next sc. *1 sc in each of next 8 sc .2 sc in next sc . Rep from* to last 4 sc .1 sc in each of last 4 sc .80 sc .
8th rnd: *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc . Rep from * around. 88 sc.
9th rnd: As 1st rnd.

Cont in this manner, inc 8 sc , as before, evenly around next and every following alt rnd, until there are 128 sc . PM (second marker at end of last rnd).
Next rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.
Rep last rnd until work from marked rnd measures 5 " $[12.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## Top Curve of Body

1st rnd: 1 sc in each of first 7 sts. Sc2tog. ${ }^{* 1}$ sc in each of next 14 sts. Sc2tog. Rep from* to last 7 sts. 1 sc in each of last 7 sts. 120 sts.
2nd and alt rnds: 1 sc in each st around.
3rd rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 13 sts. Rep from * around. 112 sts.
5th rnd: 1 sc in each of first 6 sts. Sc2tog. *1 sc in each of next 12 sts. Sc2tog. Rep from* to last 7 sts. 1 sc in each of last 7 sts. 104 sts.
7th rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. Rep from * around. 96 sts.
8th rnd: As 2nd rnd.
Cont in this manner, dec 8 sts, as before, evenly around next and every following alt rnd, until there are 56 sts.
Next rnd: 1 sc in each st around.

## Top of Body

Following manufacturer's instructions, attach safety eyes to side of Body $11 / 2$ " $[4 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] apart, approx midway down.


Stuff Body firmly.
1st rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. Rep from * around. 48 sts. 2nd rnd: 1 sc in each of first 2 sts. Sc2tog. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 4 sts. Sc2tog. Rep from* to last 2 sts. 1 sc in each of last 2 sts. 40 sts.
3rd rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * around. 32 sts. 4th rnd: 1 sc in first st. Sc2tog. *1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Sc2tog. Rep from* to last st. 1 sc in last st. 24 sts. 5th rnd: *Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * around. 16 sts.
6th rnd: (Sc2tog) 8 times. 8 sts. Fasten off, leaving long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten off. Weaving in end.

## LEAF

With A, ch 26. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring, being careful not to twist chain. See diagrams on page 6.
1st rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each ch around. Do not join. 26 sc.
Cont working in a spiral as follows:
2nd rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.
3rd rnd: 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc .2 sc in each of next 2 sc .1 sc in each of next 11 sc .2 sc in last sc. 30 sc .
4th rnd: As 2nd rnd.
5th rnd: 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc . 2 sc in each of next 2 sc .1 sc in each of next 13 sc .2 sc in last sc. 34 sc .
6th to 8th rnds: As 2nd rnd.
9th rnd: (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 13 sts. Sc2tog) twice. 30 sts.
10th and alt rnds: 1 sc in each st around.
11th rnd: (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. Sc2tog) twice. 26 sts.
13th rnd: (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. Sc2tog) twice. 22 sts. 14th rnd: As 10th rnd.
Cont in this manner, dec 4 sts, as before, evenly around next and every following alt rnd, until there are 6 sts.

## Yarnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

Next rnd: 1 sc in each st around.
Fasten off, leaving long end. Draw end tightly through rem 6 sts at tip and fasten off. Weave in end. Stuff Leaf very loosely. Fold foundation chain in half, having beg of row at side edge of Leaf.


Next rnd: (RS). Join yarn with sl st to first rem loop foundation ch. Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses of rem loops of foundation ch as follows: [(Sc2tog) 3 times. Sc3tog. (Sc2tog) twice] (Total 6 sts).
SI st in first sc.
Fasten off.


## FLOWER

Petal (Make 5)
With B, ch 2.
See diagram on page 6.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Do not join. PM for beg rnd. Move marker up on rnds as work progresses.
Cont working in a spiral as follows:
2nd rnd: (2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc .2 sc in next sc) twice. 10 sc .
3rd rnd: ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in next sc ) twice. 14 sc .
4th to 7th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.
8th rnd: (Sc2tog) 7 times. 7 sts.
Fasten off, leaving long end. Draw end tightly through rem 7 sts and fasten off. Weave in end.

## Assemble Flower

With B, sew base of all 5 petals tog, through centers of first rnds, to form Flower.


## STEM

With C, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook.
Do not join. PM for beg rnd. Move marker up on rnds as work progresses.
Cont working in a spiral as follows:
2nd rnd: 1 sc in each each sc around.
Rep last rnd until work from beg measures 3 " $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

## ASSEMBLY

## Crease

With strand of MC 75" [190.5 cm ] long and yarn needle, (weave yarn down through center from top to bottom, and back up around side of Body) 3 times tightening to create cinched crease. Fasten off.



Using yarn to match, sew Leaf, Stem and Flower to top of Peach at Crease.


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## Embroidery:

With Contrast D, embroider blush lines below each eye using Satin St.
