



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately  
**Beg** = Begin(ning)  
**Ch** = Chain(s)  
**Hdc** = Half double crochet  
**Rep** = Repeat  
**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side  
**Sc** = Single crochet  
**Sc2tog** = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

**Scbl** = Single crochet in back loop only  
**Sl st** = Slip stitch  
**St(s)** = Stitch(es)  
**WS** = Wrong side  
**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 14" [35.5 cm] tall.

## GAUGE

8 sc and 9 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- Join with sl st to first sc at end of each rnd.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook. Draw loop of next color through 2 loops on hook to complete stitch and proceed in next color.
- When working rounds with color changes, carry color not in use loosely along top of previous round, towards WS of work and work sts over yarn to prevent stranding.

## HEAD

See diagram on page 5.

With A, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 10 sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 20 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 30 sc.

**5th rnd:** As 3rd rnd.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 40 sc.

**7th to 10th rnds:** As 3rd rnd.

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Blanket™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

**Contrast A** Tan Pink (10898) **1 ball or 215 yds/197 m**

**Contrast B** Vintage White (10006) **1 ball or 48 yds/44 m**

**Bernat® Blanket™** (5.3 oz/150 g; 108 yds/98 m)

**Contrast C** Cranberry (00705) **1 ball or 22 yds/20 m**

**Bernat® Blanket™ Brights** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

**Contrast D** Go-Go Green (12004) **1 ball or 26 yds/24 m**

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® stitch markers. Polyfil stuffing. 1 pair 15 mm (½") safety eyes. Sewing pins. Small amount of black worsted weight yarn for embroidery.

## Cheeks

See diagram on page 5.

**Note:** When working following rnds, carry color not in use loosely along top of previous rnd, towards WS of work and work sts over yarn to prevent stranding.

**1st rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc. With B, (2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc) 9 times. 2 sc in next sc. With A, 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 50 sc.

**2nd rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc. With B, 1 sc in each of next 29 sc. With A, 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join.

**3rd rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc. With B, sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 25 sc. Sc2tog. With A, 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 48 sts.

**4th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. With B, sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 21 sc. Sc2tog. With A, 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join. 46 sts.

**5th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 13 sts. With B, (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc) twice. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc) twice. Sc2tog. With A, 1 sc in each st to end of rnd. Join. 40 sts.

**6th rnd:** With A, ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 10 sts. Sc2tog. With B, sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Sc2tog. With A, sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2tog. Join. 32 sts.

**7th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join. Fasten off leaving a long end to sew Head to Body during Finishing.

## EARS (make 2)

### Outer Ear

See diagram on page 5.

With A, ch 10. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sts) twice. Join. 8 sts.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts) twice. Join. 6 sts.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc) twice. Join. 4 sts.

**5th rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Join. Fasten off.

### Inner Ear

See diagram on page 5.

With B, ch 5.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch. Turn. 4 sc.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn. 2 sts.

**4th row:** Ch 1. Sc2tog. Fasten off, leaving long tail.

Using long tail, sew Inner Ear to one side of Outer Ear.

## BODY

See diagram on page 6.

With A, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 10 sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 20 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 30 sc.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 hdc in next sc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 40 hdc.

**5th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 3 hdc. Rep from \* around. Join. 50 hdc.

**7th and 8th rnds:** As 5th rnd.

**9th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 16 sc. With B, 1 sc in each of next 18 sc. With A, 1 sc in each of next 16 sc. Join.

**10th and 11th rnds:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 15 sc. With B, 1 sc in each of next 20 sc. With A, 1 sc in each of next 15 sc. Join.

**12th rnd:** With A, ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc. With B, sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 16 sc. Sc2tog. With A, 1 sc in each of next 13 sc. Sc2tog. Join. 46 sts.

**13th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 14 sts. With B, 1 sc in each of next 18 sts. With A, 1 sc in each of next 14 sts. Join.

**14th rnd:** With A, ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc) twice. With B, sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog. With A, (1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Sc2tog) twice. Join. 38 sts.

**15th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. With B, 1 sc in each of next 14 sts. With A, 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. Join.

**16th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 12 sc. With B, sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc. Sc2tog. With A, 1 sc in each of next 12 sc. Join. 36 sts.

**17th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. With B, 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. With A, 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. Join.

**18th rnd:** With A, ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc. With B, sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Sc2tog. With A, 1 sc in each of next 10 sc. Sc2tog. Join. 32 sts.

**19th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. With B, 1 sc in each of next 10 sts. With A, 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. Join. Break B.

**20th rnd:** With A, ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc around. Join. Fasten off. Stuff Body.

## TAIL

*See diagram on page 6.*

With A, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. 10 sc in ring. Join.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 20 sc.

**3rd to 9th rnds:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**10th rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc) twice. Join. 18 sts.

**11th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

**12th to 15th rnds:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**16th rnd:** Ch 1. (Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc) twice. Join. 16 sts.

**17th to 26th rnds:** As 11th rnd. Fasten off at end of last rnd, leaving a long tail to sew to Body during Finishing.

Stuff just end of Tail (approx 3" [7.5 cm]) lightly.

Sew Tail closed along last rnd.

## ARMS (make 2)

*See diagram on page 6.*

With A, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc.

**3rd to 12th rnds:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

Fasten off at end of last rnd, leaving a long tail.

Stuff Arm very lightly.

Sew Arm closed along last rnd.

## FINISHING

### Notes:

- Safety eyes cannot be moved once they are properly attached. It's best to make sure you're happy with eye placement using stitch markers before inserting them.

- Eyes on sample are positioned along 1st row of Cheeks, approx 9 sc in from each side, with approx 6 sc between eyes.

Mark eye placement with stitch markers. Following manufacturer's instructions, attach Safety Eyes at markers.

Stuff Head, placing slightly more stuffing in Cheeks.

With black worsted weight yarn, embroider nose and mouth as shown in photo.

Making sure front of Head is centered to front of Body, attach by sewing last rnd of Head to Body through front loops of 19th rnd.

Pin Ears into place at top of Head and sew into place.

Sew Arms to either side of Body, approx 1" [2.5 cm] from Belly, with top of Arm at Neck.

Pin Tail into place at center back. Sew into place along bottom and sides to neck allowing stuffed portion of Tail to be free and floppy, and sewing through just the bottom layer of Tail.

## STRAWBERRY

*See diagram on page 4.*

With C, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 8 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 12 sc.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 16 sc.

**5th rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 20 sc.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**7th rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 24 sc.

**8th rnd:** As 6th rnd.

**9th rnd:** Ch 1. \*Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 18 sts.

Fasten off.

With B, embroider 'seeds' using straight st around sides of Strawberry.

## Strawberry Top

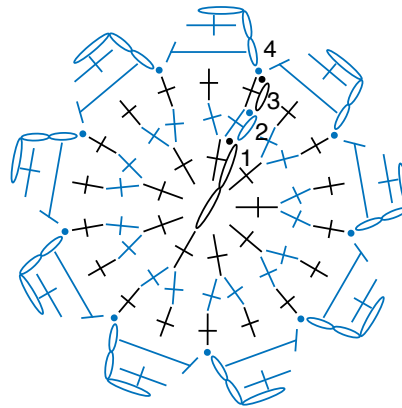
With D, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 9 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 18 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join. 18 sc.

**4th rnd:** \*(Ch 3. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in next ch. Skip next sc. Sl st in next sc) – Leaf made. Rep from \* around, ending with sl st in same sc as beg ch 3. Fasten off.



STRAWBERRY TOP

## Stem

With D, ch 5.

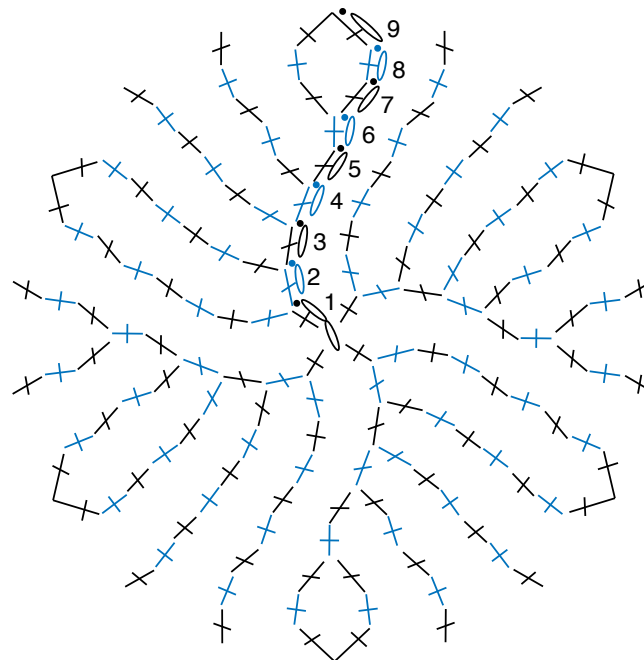
**1st row:** 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch.

Fasten off, leaving a tail approx 5" [12.5 cm] long.

Thread tail end through center of Top and secure on WS.

Stuff Strawberry. Sew Top to Strawberry, aligning sts of 3rd rnd of Top to last rnd of Strawberry.

Attach Strawberry to 'hands' at front as shown in photo, bringing yarn through just bottom layer of Arms and through sides of Strawberry.

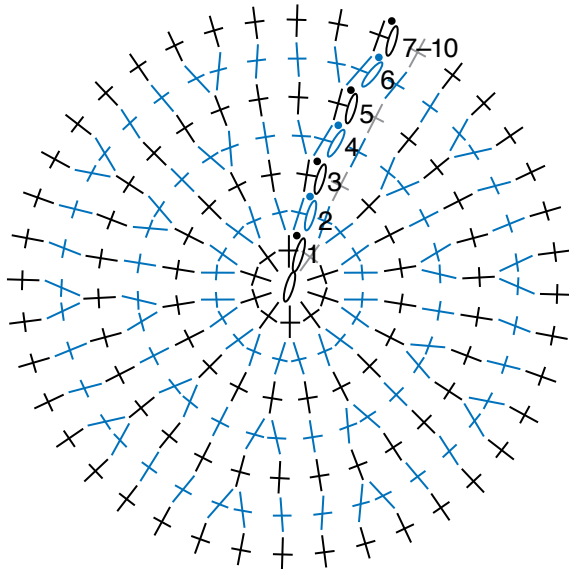

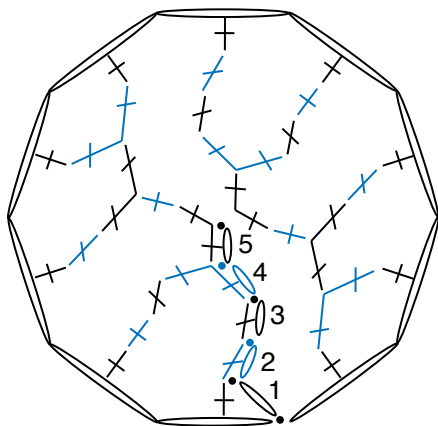

- △ = single crochet 2 together (sc2tog)



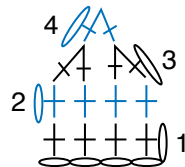
**HEAD**  
7th–14th RNDs



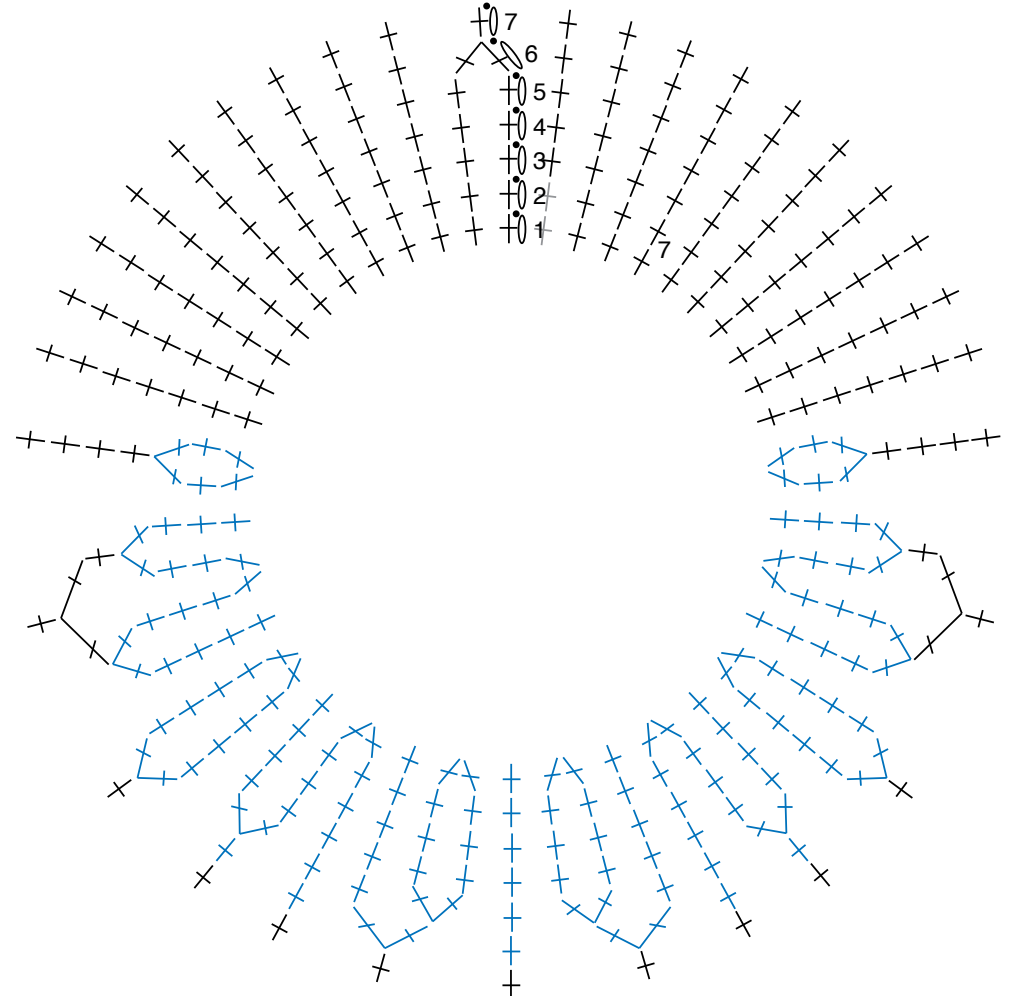
**OUTER EAR**
