## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\text {B }}$ Blanket Pet $^{\text {TM }}$ ( $8 \mathrm{oz} / 225 \mathrm{~g} ; 269 \mathrm{yds} / 246 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Navy (34022) $\mathbf{5}$ balls
Size U.S. J/10 ( 6 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Long sewing needle. Thread. 2 large buttons. 36 " $[91.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] square pillow form.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 36" [91.5 cm] square.

## GAUGE

10 sc and 10 rows $=4$ " $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Front and Back (make alike)
Note: After 1st rnd, join all rnds with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-5.
Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 15 dc in ring. Join. 16 dc .
2nd rnd: Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc and ch-2 throughout). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc . *(2 dc. Ch 2.2 dc ) in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc . Rep from * around. 1 dc in first ch- 2 sp. Join. 3rd rnd: SI st in first ch-2 sp. Ch 5. 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. 1 dc in each dc to next ch-2 sp. *(2 dc. Ch 2.2 dc ) in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each dc to next ch-2 sp. Rep from * around. 1 dc in first ch- 2 sp. Join. Rep 3rd rnd, inc 16 sts per rnd, until work measures approx 36 " [ 91.5 cm ]. Fasten off.

Join: With WS tog, join yarn with sl st to any corner ch-2 sp. Working through both thicknesses, join edges with 1 rnd of sc, inserting pillow form before joining last edge. Join with sl st to first sc.
Next rnd: Ch 1. Working from left to right instead of right to left as usual, 1 reverse sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.


Buttons: Measure and mark center of Pillow. Thread a long, sharp sewing needle and pierce through center of Pillow. Cinch tightly. Sew one button to top and bottom of Pillow at center.
