## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Dcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Dcftp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Hdc2tog** = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## SIZES

### To fit chest measurement

6 mos 17" [43 cm]

12 mos 18" [45.5 cm]

18 mos 19" [48 cm]

24 mos 20" [51 cm]

### Finished chest measurement

6 mos 19" [48.5 cm]

12 mos 21" [53.5 cm]

18 mos 23" [58.5 cm]

24 mos 25" [63.5 cm]

## GAUGE

16 hdc and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written 6 (12-18-24) mos. Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pat. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

**Notes:** Cardigan is worked in one piece from neck edge down. Ch 2 at beg of row/rnd **does not** count as hdc.

## BODY

Beg at neck edge, ch **41 (45-49-53)**.

**1st row:** 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook.

1 hdc in each ch to end of chain.

Turn. **39 (43-47-51)** hdc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 dcfp around first st. \*1 dcbp around next st. 1 dcfp around next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. 1 dcbp around first st. \*1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

Proceed with Body as follows:

**1st row:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of first **4 (5-6-7)** sts. (1 hdc. Ch 1. 1 hdc – V-st made) in next st. 1 hdc in each of next 6 sts. V-st in next st. 1 hdc in each of next **15 (17-19-21)** sts. V-st in next st. 1 hdc in each of next 6 sts. V-st in next st. 1 hdc in each of last **4 (5-6-7)** sts. Turn. **43 (47-51-55)** hdc and 4 ch-1 sps.

**Next 9 (10-11-12) rows:** Ch 2. \*1 hdc in each hdc to ch-1 sp of next V-st. V-st in ch-1 sp of next V-st. Rep from \* 3 times more. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **115 (127-139-151)** hdc and 4 ch-1 sps at end of last row.

## Divide Sleeves and Body

**1st rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of first **14 (16-18-20)** hdc. 1 hdc in ch-1 sp of V-st. Ch 4 for underarm. Skip next **26 (28-30-32)** hdc. 1 hdc in ch-1 sp of V-st. 1 hdc in each of next **35 (39-43-47)** hdc. 1 hdc in ch-1 sp of V-st. Ch 4 for underarm. Skip next **26 (28-30-32)** hdc. 1 hdc in ch-1 sp of V-st. 1 hdc in each of last **14 (16-18-20)** hdc. Turn. **75 (83-91-99)** hdc

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc or ch to end of row. Turn.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Rep last row until work from underarm measures **4½ (5½-5½-6)″ [11.5 (14-14-15) cm]**. **Do not** fasten off.

**Ribbing: 1st row:** Ch 2. 1 dcbp around first st. \*1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. 1 dcfp around first st. \*1 dcbp around next st. 1 dcfp around next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows **2 (2-3-3)** times more. Fasten off at end of last rnd.

## SLEEVES

**1st rnd:** (RS). Join yarn with sl st to 3rd ch of underarm ch. Ch 2. 1 hdc in same ch as last sl st. 1 hdc in each ch or hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. **34 (36-38-40)** hdc. Turn.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st around. Join with sl st to first hdc. Turn.

Rep last rnd (turning at end of each rnd to match Body fabric) until work from underarm ch measures **1 (1½-2-2½)″ [2.5 (4-5-6.5) cm]**.

**1st rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in first hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Join with sl st to first hdc. Turn. **32 (34-36-38)** hdc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first hdc. Turn.

Rep last 2 rnds twice more. **28 (30-32-36)** hdc.

**Next rnd:** Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first hdc. Turn.

Rep last rnd until Sleeve from underarm ch measures **4 (5-5½-6)″ [10 (12.5-14-15) cm]**.

## Sleeve Ribbing: 1st rnd:

Ch 2. 1 dcbp around first st. \*1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st. Rep from \* to last st. 1 dcfp around last st. Join with sl st to first dcbp. Rep last rnd **4 (5-5-6)** times more. Fasten off at end of last rnd.

**Right Front Band:** With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to bottom Right Front.

**1st row:** Ch 2. Work **43 (47-51-55)** hdc evenly up Right Front edge. Turn.

**\*\*2nd row:** (WS). Ch 2. 1 dcbp around first st. \*1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** (RS). Ch 2. 1 dcfp around first st. \*1 dcbp around next st. 1 dcfp around next st. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows **2 (2-3-3)** times more. Fasten off.\*\*

### Left Front Band

With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to top Left Front.

**1st row:** Ch 2. Work **43 (47-51-55)** hdc evenly down Left Front edge. Turn.

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Right Front Band.

Sew button to top of Left Front Band approx ¾" [2 cm] from top of band as shown in photo.

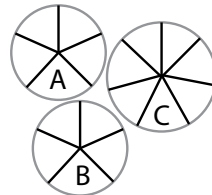
### Embroidery

Using template, embroider Wheel Roses on either side of Cardigan as follows:

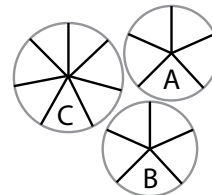
Begin by outlining "spokes" of Wheel Roses using Straight (Spoke) st.

Draw up needle in center of Wheel Rose.

Weave Wheel Rose by threading needle under next "spoke". \*Thread needle over next spoke. Thread needle under next spoke. Rep from \* until spokes are fully covered. Fasten off.



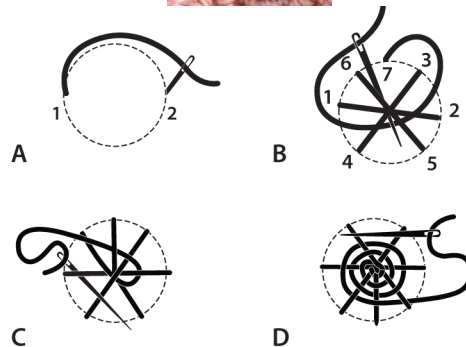
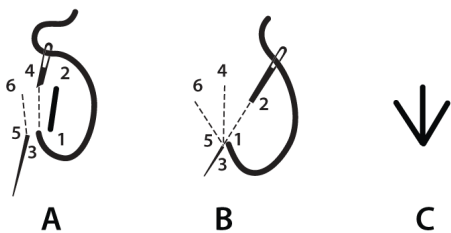
Right Front Wheel Roses
