
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WHAT YOU'LL NEED



GAUGE

10 stitches (sts) and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter Stitch (st).





Bernat® Forever Fleece™
 (9.9 oz/280 g; 194 yds/177 m)

COLORS

Quantity

 Blue Teal (61026) or Rose Hip (61003) 1 ball or 46 yds/42 m

1 ball of Bernat® Forever Fleece™ will make 4 Headbands total.

TOOLS

- Size U.S. 13 (9 mm) Susan Bates[®]
 Silvalume[®] knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.
- Susan Bates® stitch holders.
- Susan Bates® stitch markers.
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- Tape measure.

USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

SIZE

One size to fit adult head.

MEASUREMENT

Approximately (Approx) 4" [10 cm] wide.

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INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 11 stitches (sts).

Slip Knot:


Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape.





Pull the working yarn through the pretzel to create loop. Insert needle into loop and pull yarn to tighten.





Cast On:

Start with **slip knot** on left-hand needle. Insert right-hand needle through loop as with knit stitch (yarn at back, from the bottom up).





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INSTRUCTIONS

Draw yarn through stitch on needle, then transfer loop from right-hand needle back onto left.





2 stitches on needle.



Continue until there are 11 stitches **cast on**.



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INSTRUCTIONS

Knit Stitch:

With your working yarn at the back, insert your right-hand needle in the first loop, coming up from the bottom, behind the lefthand needle.



Wrap your working yarn around the righthand needle, coming up from the left and over to the right.



Pull the working yarn through the loop on your left-hand needle.



Pull loop off left-hand needle - 1 stitch knit.



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INSTRUCTIONS

Garter Stitch



Work in **Garter st** [knit (K) every row] until work from beginning (beg) measures 20" [51 cm], noting 1st row is Wrong Side (WS) and ending on a WS row.



Cast off knitwise, leaving a long tail for sewing.

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INSTRUCTIONS

Cast Off Knit-wise:

Work 2 knit stitches as normal.





Insert left-hand needle into 1st knit stitch on right-hand needle and pull it over the 2nd stitch and off the needle.





1 loop remaining on right-hand needle. Knit next stitch, then pull the loop just made over the new stitch.



Continue to last loop on right-hand needle.



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
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INSTRUCTIONS

Trim working yarn with approx. 8" [20.5 cm] tail.






Pull tail all the way through final loop.



Pull tail tight to fasten.



Finishing

Lay Headband on flat surface with Right Side (RS) facing up. Bring up each short edge to meet in middle.



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INSTRUCTIONS

Fold one short edge to form a "C" shape and the other short edge to form a backwards "C" shape, and interlock as shown in Diagram.








Fold Diagram

Sew ends tog through all thicknesses using whipstitch.



Trim yarn tails and turn RS out.
