INSTRUCTIONS

USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

NOTES

- Place marker on right side (RS) to keep track of RS & wrong side (WS) of work.
- Do not break yarn when changing colors. Carry color not in use loosely up side of work.

MEASUREMENT

Approximately (Approx) 10" [25.5 cm] square.

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
INSTRUCTIONS

SQUARE

Make 8.

With A, cast on 20 stitches (sts).







1st to 4th rows: <u>Knit</u> 4 rows, noting 1st row is Right side (RS).

















5th to 8th rows: Drop A. With B, knit 4 rows. (2 garter 'ridges').

Note: To carry color not in use up side of work, bring working yarn under and up around previous color to 'catch' it along side of work.





9th to 12th rows: Drop B. With A, knit 4 rows. (2 garter 'ridges').



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
WS = Wrong side


INSTRUCTIONS

Repeat (Rep) 5th to 12th rows 3 times more, ending with 4 rows of A.



Next row: (RS). Cast off knitwise, leaving a long tail approx 10" [25.5 cm] long for seaming.







ASSEMBLY

With RS facing, lay 2 Squares beside each other, positioning one horizontally and the other vertically.

Thread tail onto yarn needle.



Beginning (Beg) at bottom, seam Squares together (tog), aligning cast off/on sts with garter 'bumps'.





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INSTRUCTIONS

Secure at top and weave in ends through garter 'bumps' on WS of work.



Sew Squares tog as shown, alternating direction of Squares.



TOP EDGING

With RS facing and A, pick up and knit 80 sts (20 sts in each Square) along top edge of piece.

To pick up sts along edge of Squares with cast off edge at top, insert left-hand needle into st and place on needle. Knit into picked up st as usual.









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INSTRUCTIONS

To pick up and knit along top of Squares with side edge at top, Insert left-hand needle into side of garter 'ridge' and place on needle. Knit into picked up st as usual.







Next row: (Wrong Side - WS). Cast off knitwise.

Fold Bag in half and sew side seam. Sew bottom seam.





INSERT ZIPPER

Pin zipper into place along top edge of Bag.





Using Coats & Clark™ All Purpose Thread and a sewing needle, sew zipper into place along top edge.
