

BERNAT KNIT CHEVRON COWL | KNIT



MATERIALS

Bernat[®] **Velvet**[™] (10.5 oz/300 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Contrast A Quiet Pink (32013) 1 ball **Contrast B** Indigo Velvet (32007) 1 ball

Size U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.





KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$

Pat = Pattern

P2sso = Pass 2 slipped stitches

over

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

SI2K = Slip next 2 stitches

knitwise

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

 $\mathbf{Yo} = \mathbf{Yarn} \ \mathbf{over}$

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 14" [35.5 cm] wide x 50" [127 cm] around.

GAUGE

12 sts and 17 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With A, work 14 rows. With B, work 14 rows. These 28 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 51 sts.

1st row: (RS). K1. ssk. *K9. Sl2K. K1. p2sso. Rep from * to last 12 sts. K9. K2tog. K1.

2nd row: P6. *(P1. yo. P1) all in same st. P9. Rep from * to last 7 sts. (P1. yo. P1) all in same st. P6. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep these 2 rows until work from beg measures approx 50" [127 cm], ending with 14 rows of B. Cast off loosely.

FINISHING

Sew cast on and cast off edges tog, matching peaks and valleys of pat.
