

SIZE
One size to fit average woman's head.

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\circ}$ Super Value ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ (197 g/7 oz; $389 \mathrm{~m} / 426$ yds)


Natural (07414)
1 ball

Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

## GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stocking st.

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ABBREVIATIONS: www.bernat.com/abbreviations
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Alt = Alternate(ing).
Approx = Approximately.
$\mathbf{C 2 F}=$ Knit into front loop of 2nd stitch on left-hand needle, then knit 1st stitch, slipping both stitches off needle together.
C2L = Purl through back loop of 2nd stitch on left-hand needle (behind first stitch), then knit first stitch, slipping both stitches off needle together.
$\mathbf{C 2 R}=$ Knit into front loop of 2nd stitch on left-hand needle, then purl first stitch, slipping both stitches off needle together.
Cont $=$ Continue(ity).

## K = Knit.

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches
together.
$\mathrm{P}=$ Purl.
P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches
together.
Pat = Pattern.
Rem = Remaining .
Rep $=$ Repeat.
RS = Right side.
St(s) = Stitch(es).
WS $=$ Wrong side .

## INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 114 sts.
1st row: (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd row: K1. *C2L. C2R. Rep from * to last st. K1.
4th row: P1. K1. *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 4 sts. P2. K1. P1.
5th row: K1. P1. *C2F. P2. Rep from * to last 4 sts. C2F. P1. K1.
6th row: As 4th row.
7th row: K1. *C2R. C2L. Rep from * to last st. K1.
8th row: As 2nd row.
Rep these 8 rows once more.
Next row: (Fold ridge). Purl.

Proceed as follows, reversing rows from RS to WS as follows:
1st row: (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.
3rd and 4th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows once more.
5th row: K1. *C2L. C2R. Rep from * to last st. K1.
6th row: P1. K1. *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 4 sts. P2. K1. P1.
7th row: K1. P1. *C2F. P2. Rep from * to last 4 sts. C2F. P1. K1.
8th row: As 6th row.
9th row: K1. *C2R. C2L. Rep from * to last st. K1.
10th row: As 2nd row.
11th and 12th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows.
These 12 rows form pat.
Cont in pat until work from fold ridge measures approx $51 / 2$ " $[14 \mathrm{~cm}]$, ending with 10th row of pat.

Shape top: 1 st row: (RS). K2. P2. K2. *P2tog. K2. (P2. K2) twice. Rep from

* to end of row. 105 sts.

2nd and alt rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.
3rd row: K2. P2. K2. *P1. K2. P2tog. K2. P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 96 sts.
5th row: K2. P2tog. K2. *(P1. K2) twice. P2tog. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 86 sts.
7th row: K2. P1. K2. *P1. K2tog. (P1. K2) twice. Rep from * to end of row. 77 sts.
9th row: K2. P1. K2tog. *P1. K1. P1. K2tog. P1. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 67 sts.

11th row: K2tog. P1. K1. *(P1. K1) twice. P1. K2tog. Rep from * to end of row. 57 sts.

13th row: K1. *K2tog. Rep from * to end of row. 29 sts.
Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end through rem sts. Pull tightly. Fasten securely. Sew center back seam, reversing seam for cuff turnback.

Pompom: Wind yarn around 4 fingers 60 times. Tie tightly in the middle and leave a long end for attaching to top of hat. Cut loops at both ends and trim to form pompom. Sew to top of Hat.
