

KNIT STARTER SCARF







WHAT YOU'LL NEED







• **Bernat[®] Forever Fleece**[™] (9.9 oz/280 g; 194 yds/177 m)

COLORS

Quantity


 Blue Teal (61026) or Rose Hip (61003) 2 balls or 327 yds/299 m

TOOLS

- Size U.S. 13 (9 mm) Susan Bates[®]
 Silvalume[®] knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.
- Susan Bates[®] yarn needle.
- Tape measure.

<u>GAUGE</u>

10 sts and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st (Knit on Right Side rows. Purl on Wrong Side rows).



ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately Beg = Beginning Cont = Continue(ity) K = Knit P = Purl RS = Right side St(s) = Stitch(es) SI1P = Slip 1 stitch purl-wise - Insert the needle into the stitch purlwise and pass the stitch to the right-hand needle without working it. WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 9" x 70" [23 cm x 178 cm].




INSTRUCTIONS

Slip Knot:


Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape.

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
With tip of needle, pull working yarn through the pretzel to create loop and pull yarn to tighten.



Cast on 25 stitches (sts).


Cast On:

Start with slip knot on left-hand needle.





Insert right-hand needle through loop as with knit stitch (yarn at back, from the bottom up).





INSTRUCTIONS

Start knit stitch, then transfer loop from right-hand needle back onto left. 2 stitches on needle.

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Continue (cont) casting on in this same manner until there are 25 sts on needle.

1st row: [Wrong side (WS)]. Knit.




INSTRUCTIONS

Knit 1 (K1) *Insert right-hand needle from left to right through front of next stitch on lefthand needle.


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
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


Wrap working yarn counter-clockwise around right-hand needle

Pull through a loop, dropping stitch from left-hand needle - 1 stitch knit.








Repeat (rep) from * until all 25 stitches (sts) (K25) will be knit.

1st row complete.



INSTRUCTIONS

Repeat 1st row [knit (K) every row – garter stitch] until work from beginning (beg) measures 4" [10 cm], noting 1st row is Wrong Side (WS) and ending on a WS row.


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Next row: [Right side (RS)]. Slip 1 Purl-wise (Sl1P) Knit to end of row.

<u>Slip 1 Purl-wise</u>:





Do not work stitch, simply slip it onto right-hand needle. If next stitch will be knit, move yarn to back of work **between** needles.



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INSTRUCTIONS

Next row: (WS). SI1P. Purl to end of row. <u>Purl 1 (P1)</u> Going under needle, reposition working yarn from back of work

to front of work. *Insert right-hand needle from right to left through **front** of next stitch on left-hand needle. Wrap working yarn counter-clockwise around right-hand needle.

Pull up a loop through back of stitch and *slip stitch off left-hand needle -* 1 purl stitch complete.

Repeat (rep) from * until all 25 stitches (sts) will be on right-hand needle.


Rep last 2 rows (Stocking st) until work from beg measures 8" [20.5 cm], ending on a RS (knit) row.

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INSTRUCTIONS

Continue (cont) working 4" [10 cm] of **garter st** and 4" [10 cm] of **stocking st** until Scarf from beg measures approx 70" [178 cm], ending with 4" [10 cm] of garter st and RS row.

Cast off knit-wise.

Cast Off Knit-wise:


Work 2 knit stitches as normal. Insert left-hand needle into 1st knit stitch on right-hand needle and pull it over the 2nd stitch and off the needle.


1 loop remaining (rem) on right-hand needle.


Knit next stitch, then pull the loop just made over the new stitch.

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


INSTRUCTIONS

Continue to last loop on right-hand needle.

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Trim working yarn with approx 4" [10 cm] tail. Pull tail all the way through final loop. Pull tail tight to tie knot.

Weave in ends.



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
