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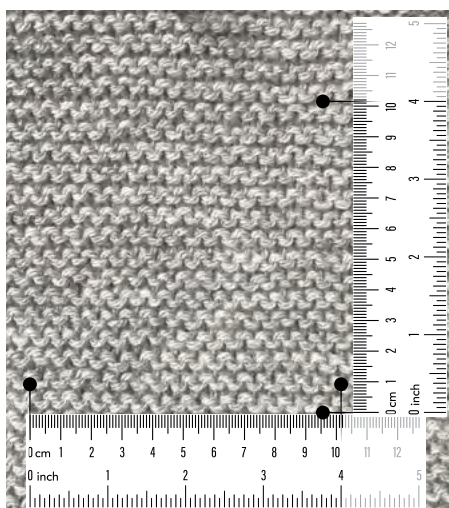
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WHAT YOU'LL NEED



GAUGE

16 sts and 30 rows = 4" [10 cm]
in garter stitch (knit every row).



YARN

- **Bernat® Super Value™**
(7 oz/197 g; 440 yds/402 m)

COLORS

Quantity

- **Contrast A** Peony Pink (53417)
1 ball or 365 yds/334 m
- **Contrast B** Soft Grey (53046)
1 ball or 365 yds/334 m

TOOLS

- Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- Tape measure.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately	K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together	St(s) = Stitch(es)
Beg = Beginning	Rem = Remain(ing)	Tog = Together
Dec(s) = Decrease(s)	Rep = Repeat	WS = Wrong side
K = Knit	RS = Right side	Yo = Yarn over

INSTRUCTIONS

USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

NOTE

- Shawl is knit side to side working back and forth in rows across circular needle. Shawl begins at first tip with Contrast A and then increases to center before joining Contrast B and decreasing down to opposite tip. Yarn over (yo) technique is used to make eyelet hole increases and on Contrast B side, 2 decreases are worked with yo between them to maintain the same effect.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 64" long x 30" deep [162.5 x 76 cm], excluding tassels.

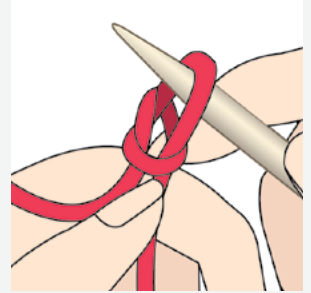
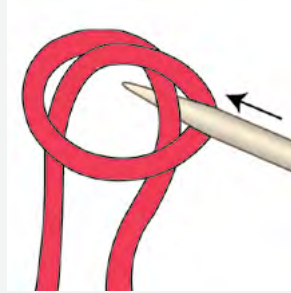
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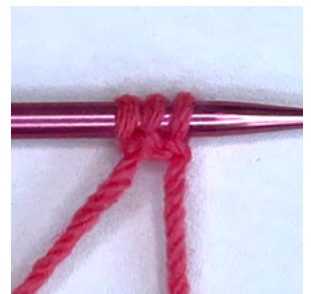
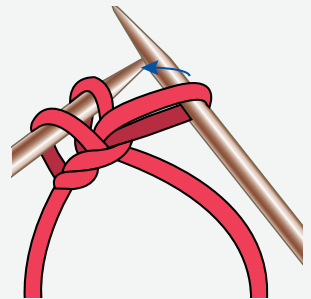
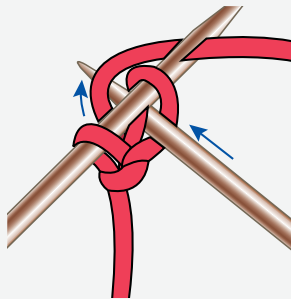
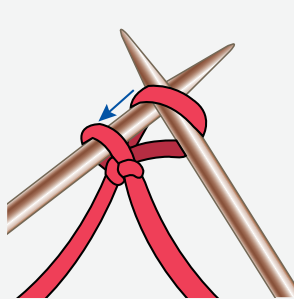
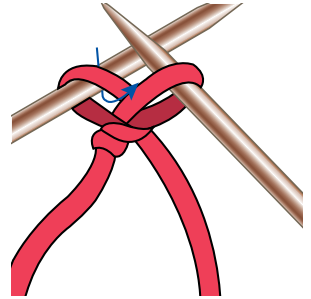
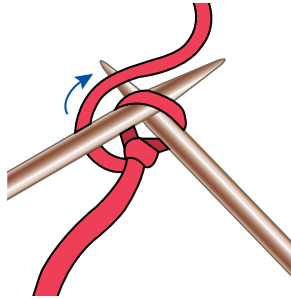
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INSTRUCTIONS

Slip knot



With A, **cast on** 3 stitches (sts).



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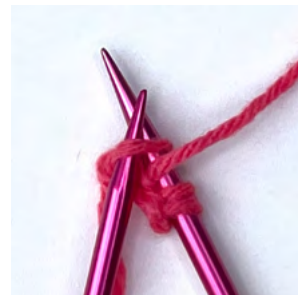
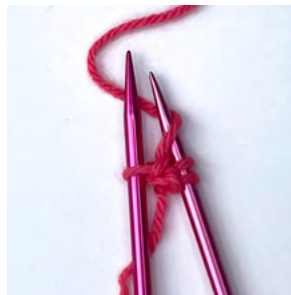
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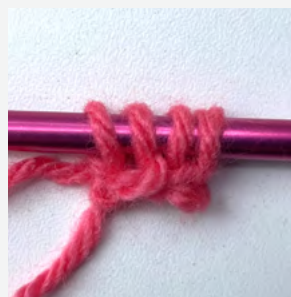
1st row: [Right side (RS)]. **Knit** 2 (K2).



Yarn over (yo) to create a stitch.



K1. 4 sts.



2nd row: Knit.

Note: When knitting into the yo, insert needle from front to back through yo and knit as usual.



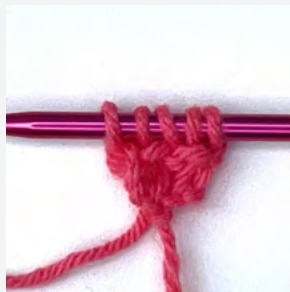
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INSTRUCTIONS

3rd row: K2. yo. Knit to end of row. 5 sts.

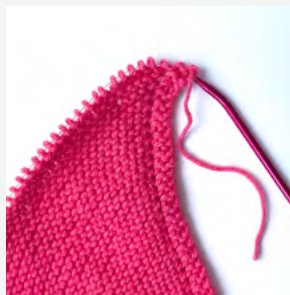


4th row: Knit.

Repeat (rep) last 2 rows, increasing (inc) 1 st every RS row at beginning (beg) of needle after first 2 knit sts until there are 120 sts, ending on a wrong side (WS) row.



Note: RS of your work will look like this, yo increases will be 2 sts in from right edge, with a straight edge on the left edge.



When you have 120 sts on needle, ending on a WS row, break A, leaving a tail approx 4" [10 cm] long for weaving in later.

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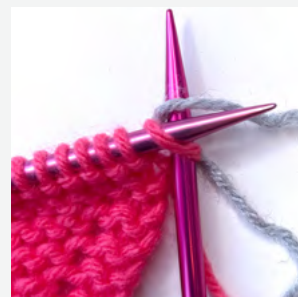
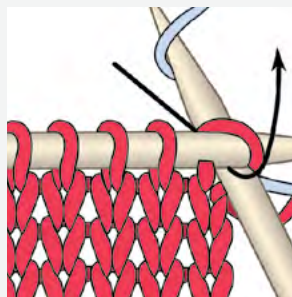
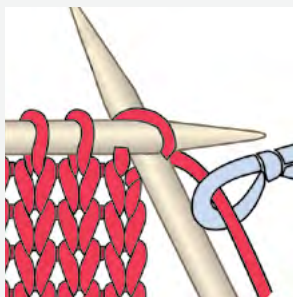
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INSTRUCTIONS

JOIN NEW COLOR B AND BEGIN DECREASES (DEC'S)

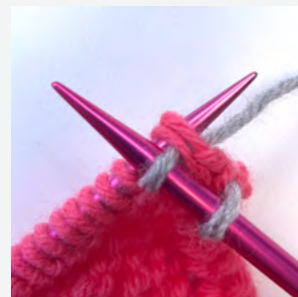
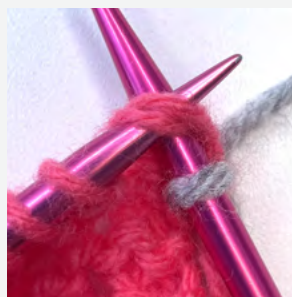
1st row: (RS). With B, K1.



Knit next 2 sts together (K2tog).

Knit next 2 sts together (K2tog).

*Knit next 2 stitches together by inserting right-hand needle into next 2 stitches at same time (inserting needle from **left** to **right**)*



and knitting both of these 2 stitches together as one.



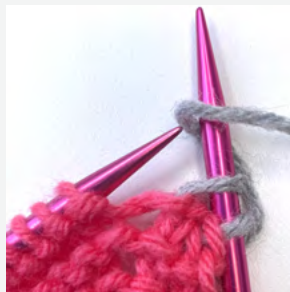
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INSTRUCTIONS

yo. K2tog. Knit to end of row.



1st row complete.

Row just worked: *"1st row: K1. K2tog. yo.
K2tog. Knit to end of row."*



2nd row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows, decreasing (dec) 1 st every RS row at beginning (beg) of row until there are 4 sts remaining (rem), ending on a WS row.

Note: RS of your work should look like this – decreases will be along the right edge, and the left edge will remain straight. Eyelets created by yo will stay consistent.



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INSTRUCTIONS

When 4 sts remain (rem), proceed as follows:

Next row: (RS). K1. K2tog. K1. 3 sts.



4 sts rem.



K1. K2tog. K1. 3 sts.

Cast off:

Cast off by knitting first 2 sts.



Insert left-hand needle into first st on right-hand needle, and pass it over the second st.



Knit last st on left-hand needle and rep last st, passing first st over second. 1 st remain (rem).



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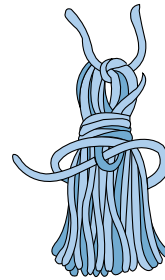
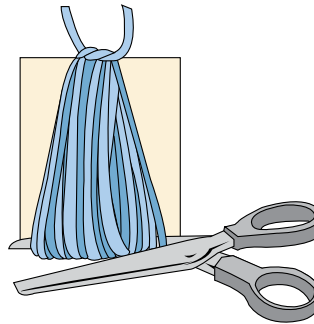
Cut yarn and pull through last st to fasten off.



TASSELS

Make 1 each in A and B.

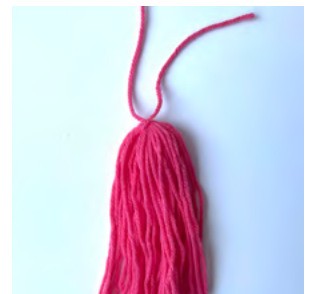
Wrap yarn around a 6" [15 cm] piece of cardboard 30 times.



Using length of yarn 10" [25.5 cm] long, tie securely at one end. Ends will be used later to attach Tassel to Shawl.



Cut across other end.



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Wrap yarn tightly 6 times around Tassel 1" [2.5 cm] from tied end and fasten securely by threading end behind yarn just wrapped and bringing tail into Tassel.



Trim ends of Tassel evenly. Using long yarn end at top of Tassel, sew to Shawl at either tip, contrasting colors as shown.
