

## BERNAT ${ }^{\circledR}$ HANDICRAFTER COTTON BERNAT ${ }^{\circledR}$ SATIN <br> MOM'S ANKLE SOCKS (TO KNIT)

## SIZES

Finished foot length
Small 9 ins [ 23 cm ]
Medium $91 / 2$ ins [ 24 cm ]
Large $101 / 2$ ins $[26.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]
X-Large 11 ins [ 28 cm ]

## GAUGE

19 sts and 25 rows $=4$ ins $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stocking st.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Beg $=$ Beginning.
Cont = Continue(ity).
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit.
$\mathbf{K 2} \mathbf{t o g}=$ Knit next 2 stitches together. P = Purl.
P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together.
Pat $=$ Pattern.
Psso = Pass slipped stitch over.
Rem $=$ Remaining.
Rep $=$ Repeat.
$\operatorname{Rnd}(\boldsymbol{s})=\operatorname{Round}(s)$.
RS = Right side.
Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise.
$\operatorname{St}(\mathrm{s})=\operatorname{Stitch}(\mathrm{es})$.
Tog = Together.
WS = Wrong side.

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\otimes}$ Handicrafter Cotton ( $50 \mathrm{~g} / 1.75 \mathrm{oz} /$ $73 \mathrm{~m} / 80 \mathrm{yds}$ )
or Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Satin ( $100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 149 \mathrm{~m} / 163 \mathrm{yds}$ )
Size S (M-L-XL)
Main Color (MC) (White)
100 (105-110-120) m
OR
110 (115-120-130) yds
Contrast A (Blue)
100 (105-110-120) m
OR
110 (115-120-130) yds
Set of four size 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

## Stripe Pat

With A, knit 2 rnds.
With MC, knit 2 rnds.
These 4 rnds form Stripe pat.
With MC, cast on 40 (40-44-44) sts loosely. Divide into 13 (13-14-14) sts onto 1 st and 2 nd needles and 14 (14-16-16) sts onto 3rd needle. Join in rnd. Mark first st with contrast thread.
Knit 3 rnds.
Make heel: Slip first 10 (10-11-11) sts from first needle and last 10 (10-11-11) sts from 3rd needle onto one needle for heel having contrast marker in center. Leave 20 (20-22-22) sts on 2 needles for instep. Break yarn.

With WS of work facing, rejoin A to 20 (20-22-22) heel sts and work back and forth as follows: 1st row: (WS). Sl1. Purl to end of row. 2nd row: *Sl1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows until heel measures $2\left(2-2^{1 / 2}-\mathbf{2}^{1 / 2}\right)$ ins [ $5(5-6-6) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending with a 1 st row.

Shape heel: 1st row: P13 (13-14-14). P2tog. P1. Turn.
2nd row: Sl1. K7. Sl1. K1. psso. K1. Turn. 3rd row: Sl1. P8. P2tog. P1. Turn.
4th row: Sl1. K9. Sl1. K1. psso. K1. Turn.
5th row: Sl1. P10. P2tog. P1. Turn.
6th row: Sl1. K11. Sl1. K1. psso. K1. Turn. 14 (14-16-16) sts.

Sizes L and XL only: 7th row: Sl1. P12. P2tog. Turn.
8th row: Sl1. K12. Sl1. K1. psso. 14 sts.

All sizes: With RS of work facing, pick up and knit 10 (10-11-12) sts along side of left heel. With 2nd needle K20 (20-22-22) from instep. With 3rd needle pick up and knit 10 (10-11-12) sts along side of right heel. Knit first 7 sts from heel onto end of 3rd needle. Slip rem 7 sts from heel onto beg of 1 st needle. 54 (54-58-60) sts are now divided: 17 ( $\mathbf{1 7 -}$ 18-19) sts on 1st needle, 20 (20-22-22) sts on 2nd needle and 17 (17-18-19) sts on 3rd needle.
Work in Stripe Pat as follows:
1st rnd: 1st needle: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle: Knit. 3rd needle: K1. S11. K1. psso. Knit to end of needle.
2nd rnd: Knit.
Rep last 2 rnds to 40 (40-44-44) sts divided as 10 (10-11-11) sts on 1 st needle, 20 (20-22-22) sts on 2nd needle and 10 (10-11-11) sts on 3rd needle.

Cont even in Stripe Pat until foot from picked up sts at heel measures $61 / 4\left(6^{3} / 4-7-7^{1 / 2}\right)$ ins $[16(\mathbf{1 7 - 1 8 - 1 9}) \mathrm{cm}]$.

Shape toe: 1st rnd: 1st needle: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle: K1. Sl1. K1. psso. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3 rd needle: K1. S11. K1. psso. Knit to end of needle.
2nd rnd: Knit.
Rep last 2 rnds 4 (4-5-5) times more. 20 sts.
Knit sts from 1st needle onto 3rd needle. Graft 2 sets of 10 sts tog for toe.
