## SIZES

## To fit bust measurement:

Extra-Small/Small: 28-34" (71-86.5 cm) Medium: 36-38" (91.5-96.5 cm) Large: 40-42" (101.5-106.5 cm) Extra-Large: 44-46" (112-117 cm) 2/3 X-Large: 48-54" (122-137 cm) 4/5 X-Large: 56-62" (142-157.5 cm)

## Finished bust

Extra-Small/Small: 36" ( 91.5 cm )
Medium: 40" (101.5 cm) Large: 44" ( 112 cm )
Extra-Large: 48" (122 cm)
2/3 X-Large: 54" (137 cm) 4/5 X-Large: 62" ( 157.5 cm )

## GAUGE

13 sts and 24 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in garter st.

## MATERIALS

| Sizes | XS/S | M | L | XL | 2-3XL | $4-5 \mathrm{XL}$ |  |
| Red (06004) | 5 | 5 | 6 | 6 | 7 | 8 | balls |

Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) circular knitting needle 36 " [ 91.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch holder. 2 buttons approximately 1 " $[2.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in diameter.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

Beg $=$ Begin(ning)
Cont $=$ Continue $\mathbf{K}=$ Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together $\mathbf{R S}=$ Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side Yo = Yarn over

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: Cardigan is worked sideways in one piece to from cuff to cuff.

Beginning (beg) at Left Sleeve, cast on 46 (46-48-48-50-52) stitches (sts). Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Proceed in garter stitch (knit every row), noting first row is wrong side (WS), until total length measures $7\left(7-6 \frac{1}{2}-61 / 2-6-5 \frac{1}{2}\right)$ " $[18$ ( $18-$ $16.5-16.5-15-14) \mathrm{cm}$, ending on a WS row .
Shape Back and Front: Cast on 32 (36-38-40-42-46) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 110 (118-124-128-134-144) sts.

Continue (cont) even in garter st until work from last cast on row measures $51 / 2(61 / 2$ $71 / 4-81 / 4-91 / 2-111 / 2$ )" [14 (16.5-18.5-21-2428) cm ], ending on a WS row.

Divide for Neck: 1st row: [Right side (RS)]. K52 (56-59-61-64-69) and place on st holder for Back. Cast off 16 sts for neck. Knit to end of row.

Cont in garter st on these 42 (46-49-51-5459) sts for Left Front until work from from divide measures $31 / 2(31 / 2-33 / 4-33 / 4-4-4)^{\prime \prime}$ [ 9 (9-9.5-9.5-10-10) cm], ending on a RS row. Cast off.

Join yarn to 52 (56-59-61-64-69) sts on holder for Back. Work in garter st until work
from join measures 7 (7-71/2-71/2-8-8)" [18 (18-19-19-20.5-20.5) cm], ending on a RS row. Place sts on st holder.

Right Front: Cast on 42 (46-49-51-54-59) sts. Work in garter st until Right Front measures $31 / 2\left(31 / 2-3^{3} / 4-33 / 4-4-4\right)$ " $[9$ ( $9-9.5-9.5-10-$ 10) cm ], ending on a RS row.

Join Back and Front: Next row: (WS). K42 (46-49-51-54-59). Cast on 16 sts. K52 (56-59-61-64-69) from Back st holder. 110 (118-124-128-134-144) sts.
Cont in garter st until work from Join Back and Front measures $51 / 2(61 / 2-71 / 4-81 / 4-91 / 2-$ $111 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ [14 (16.5-18.5-21-24-28) cm], ending on a RS row.

Divide for Right Sleeve: Cast off 32 (36-38-40-42-46) sts at beg of next 2 rows. 46 (46-48-48-50-52) sts. Cont in garter st until Right Sleeve measures 7 ( $7-6^{1 / 2}-6 \frac{1}{2}-6-5^{1 / 2}$ )" [18 (18-16.5-16.5-15-14) cm], ending on a RS row. Cast off.

## Sleeve Tabs (make 2)

Cast on 16 sts. Knit 4 rows (garter st).
Buttonhole row: K3. Knit next 2 stitches together (K2tog). Yarn over (yo). Knit to end of row.
Knit 4 rows. Cast off.

## Finishing

Sew side and underarm seams. Try on Cardigan, roll Sleeves and mark desired placement for Sleeve Tabs and buttons. Sew on Sleeve Tab to inside of Sleeves, leaving buttonhole end free. Sew buttons to outside of Sleeves.
