Sizes 4.5 (U.S. 7) and 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Cable needle. 2 st holders.

## STITCH GLOSSARY

Alt $=$ Alternate.
$\mathbf{B e g}=$ Beginning.
C6F = Slip next 3 stitches onto a cable needle and leave at front of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle. $\mathbf{C 6 B}=$ Slip next 3 stitches onto a cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle.
Cont $=$ Continue(ity).
Dec = Decrease(ing).
Inc = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit.
$\mathbf{K} 2 \boldsymbol{t o g}=$ Knit next 2 stitches together. K2togtbl $=$ Knit next 2 stitches together through back loops.
M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop.


M1P = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and purling into back of loop. $\mathbf{P}=$ Purl.
P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together.
P2togtbl = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops.
Pat = Pattern.
Rep = Repeat.
Rem = Remaining.
RS = Right side.
St(s) $=$ Stitch (es).

T4B = Slip next stitch onto a cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then P1 from cable needle.
T4F = Slip next 3 stitches onto a cable needle and leave at front of work. P1, then K3 from cable needle. T5B = Slip next 2 stitches onto a cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then P2 from cable needle. T5F = Slip next 3 stitches onto a cable needle and leave at front of work. P2, then K3 from cable needle. T7B = Slip next 4 stitches onto a cable needle and leave at back of work. K3, then (P1. K3) from cable needle. WS = Wrong side.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

Panel Pat A (worked over 46 sts) (see page 34 ).
1st row: (RS). (P1. K3) twice. P6. K3. P1. K3. P4. K3. P1. K3. P6. (K3. P1) twice.
2nd and alt rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.
3rd row: T4B. P1. T4F. P3. (T5B.
P1. T5F) twice. P3. T4B. P1. T4F.
5th row: K3. P3. T5F. T4B. P5. C6F. P5. T4F. T5B. P3. K3.

7th row: T4F. P4. C6F. P5. T4B.
T4F. P5. C6F. P4. T4B.
9th row: P1. T4F. P1. T5B. T4F. P3. T4B. P2. T4F. P3. T4B. T5F. P1. T4B. P1.
11th row: P2. T7B. (P3. K3) twice. P4. (K3. P3) twice. T7B. P2.
13th row: P1. T4B. P1. T5F. T4B. P3. T4F. P2. T4B. P3. T4F. T5B. P1. T4F. P1.
15th row: T4B. P4. C6F. P5. T4F. T4B. P5. C6F. P4. T4F.
17th row: K3. P3. T5B. T4F. P5. C6F. P5. T4B. T5F. P3. K3.
19th row: T4F. P1. T4B. P3. (T4F. P3. T4B) twice. P3. T4F. P1. T4B.
21st row: (P1. K3) twice. P3. (P2. T4F.
P1. T4B) twice. P5. (K3. P1) twice.
23rd row: P1. T7B. P6. T7B. P4. T7B. P6. T7B. P1.
24th row: As 2nd row.
These 24 rows form Panel Pat A.
Panel Pat B (worked over 6 sts) (see page 34 ).
1st row: (RS). C6B.
2nd and alt rows: P6.
3rd, 5th and 7th rows: K6.
8th row: As 2nd row.
These 8 rows form Panel Pat B.
Panel Pat C (worked over 6 sts) (see page 34).
1st row: (RS). C6F.
2nd and alt rows: P6.
3rd, 5th and 7th rows: K6.
8th row: As 2nd row.
These 8 rows form Panel Pat C.

## BACK

**With smaller needles, cast on 80 (92-96-108-124-144) sts.
1st row: (RS). (P1. K1) 6 (9-10-13-17-22) times. P1. K5. P3. K6. P5. K6. P4. K6. P5. K6. P3. K5. (P1. K1) 6 (9-10-13-17-22) times. P1.
2nd row: (K1. P1) 6 (9-10-13-1722) times. K1. P5. K3. P6. K5. P6. K4. P6. K5. P6. K3. P5. (K1. P1) 6 (9-10-13-17-22) times. K1.
Rep last 2 rows 10 times more.
Next row: (RS). (P1. K1) 6 (9-10-13-17-22) times. P1. K2. M1. K3. P1. M1P. P2. K3. M1. K3. P2. M1P. P3. K3. M1. K3. P4. K3. M1. K3. P3. M1P. P2. K3. M1. K3. P2. M1. P1. K3. M1. K2. (P1. K1) 6 (9-10-13-17-22) times. P1. 90 (102-106-118-134-154) sts.
Next row: (K1. P1) 6 (9-10-13-17-22) times. K1. P6. K4. P3. K1. P3. K6. P7. K4. P7. K6. P3. K1. P3. K4. P6. (K1. P1) 6 (9-10-13-17-22) times. K1.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). K13 (19-21-27-3545). Work 1st row of Panel Pat B. P3. Work 1st row of Panel Pat A. P3. Work 1st row of Panel Pat C. K13 (19-21-27-35-45).
2nd row: P13 (19-21-27-35-45). Work 2nd row of Panel Pat C. K3. Work 2nd row of Panel Pat A. K3. Work 2nd row of Panel Pat B. P13 (19-21-27-35-45).
Panel Pats A, B and C are now in position.

Cont in pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on 5th and following 14th row. 94 (106-110-122-138-158) sts.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures $14^{1 / 2}\left(141 / 2-141 / 2-15^{1 / 2}\right.$ $161 / 2-171 / 2)$ ins [ 37 (37-37-39.5-42$44.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending with a WS row.

Shape armholes: Keeping cont of pat, cast off 5 (8-8-10-12-16) sts beg of next 2 rows. 84 (90-94-102-114126) sts.

Keeping cont of pat, dec 1 st each end of needle on next 3 (3-3-5-7-9) rows, then every following alt row 3 (5-5-4-5-7) times. 72 (74-78-84-9094) sts.**

Cont even in pat until armholes measure 8 ( $8-81 / 2-81 / 2-9-91 / 2$ ) ins [20.5 (20.5-21.5-21.5-23-24) cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders: Cast off 7 (7-8-9-10-11) sts beg next 2 rows, then 8 (8-9-10-11-11) sts beg following 2 rows. Leave rem 42 (44-44-46-4850) sts on a st holder.

## FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures $5\left(5-5-5-5 \frac{1}{2}-51 / 2\right)$ ins [12.5 (12.5-12.5-12.5-14-14) cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape neck: 1st row: Pat 20 (20-22-24-26-27) sts (neck edge). Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 rows, then following alt row once. 15 (15-17-19-21-22) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures 8 ( $\left.8-8 \frac{1}{2}-8^{1 / 2}-9-91 / 2\right)$ ins [20.5 (20.5-21.5-21.5-23-24) cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off 7 (7-8-9-10-11) sts beg of next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 8 (8-9-10-11-11) sts.

With RS of work facing, slip next 32 (34-34-36-38-40) sts onto a st holder. Join yarn to rem sts and pat to end of row.
Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 rows, then following alt row once. 15 (15-17-19-21-22) sts.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures 8 ( $8-8^{1 / 2-81 / 2-9-91 / 2}$ ) ins [20.5 (20.5-21.5-21.5-23-24) cm], ending with a RS row.

Shape shoulder: Cast off 7 (7-8-9-10-11) sts beg of next row. Work 1 row even. Cast off rem 8 (8-9-10-11-11) sts.

## SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 48 (48-48-52-56-56) sts.
1st row: (RS). (K1. P1) 8 (8-8-9-1010) times. (K4. P2) twice. K4. (P1. K1) 8 (8-8-9-10-10) times.
2nd row: (P1. K1) 8 (8-8-9-10-10) times. (P4. K2) twice. P4. (K1. P1) 8 (8-8-9-10-10) times.
Rep last 2 rows 13 times more.
Next row: (RS). (K1. P1) 8 (8-8-9-10-10) times. (K1. M1. K2. M1. K1. P2) twice. K1. M1. K2. M1. K1. (P1. K1) 8 (8-8-9-10-10) times. 54 (54-54-58-62-62) sts.
Next row: (P1. K1) 8 (8-8-9-10-10) times. (P6. K2) twice. P6. (K1. P1) 8 (8-8-9-10-10) times.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). K16 (16-16-18-2020). (Work 1st row of Panel Pat B. P2) twice. Work 1st row of Panel Pat B. K16 (16-16-18-20-20).

2nd row: P16 (16-16-18-20-20). (Work 2nd row of Panel Pat B. P2) twice. Work 2nd row of Panel Pat B. P16 (16-16-18-20-20).
Panel Pat B is now in position.
Keeping cont of pat, inc 1 st each end of needle on next and every following 8th (6th-6th-4th-2nd-2nd) row to 64 (68-72-64-70-94) sts, then every following 10th (8th-8th-6th-4th-4th)
row to 66 (72-78-82-96-106) sts, taking inc sts into stocking st.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures $17^{1 / 2}(\mathbf{1 8}-181 / 2-181 / 2-17-16)$ ins [44.5 (45.5-47-47-43-40.5) cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape top: Cast off 3 (4-4-5-6-8) sts beg next 2 rows. 60 (64-70-72-8490) sts.

Next row: (RS). K2. K2tog. Pat to last 4 sts. K2togtbl. K2.
Next row: Work even in pat.
Rep last 2 rows 8 (9-8-9-15-18) times more. 42 (44-52-52-52-52) sts.

Next row: (RS). K2. K2tog. Pat to last 4 sts. K2togtbl. K2.
Next row: P2. P2togtbl. Pat to last 4 sts. P2tog. P2.
Rep last 2 rows to 10 (12-12-12-1616) sts. Cast off.

## FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Collar: Sew right shoulder seam. With RS of work facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 15 (15-15-17-19-19) sts down left front neck edge. Pat 32 (34-34-36-38-40) sts from front st holder. Pick up and knit 15 (15-15-17-19-19) sts up right front neck edge. Pat 42 (44-44-

46-48-50) sts from back st holder. 104 (108-108-116-124-128) sts.
1st row: (WS). Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts across next 42 (44-44-46-48-50) sts. (K1. P1) 7 (7-7-8-9-9) times. K1. Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts across next 32 (34-34-36-38-40) sts. (K1. P1) 7 (7-7-8-9-9) times. K1.
