19 sts and 27 rows $=4$ ins $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stocking st.

## MATERIALS

## Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Handicrafter Cotton

( $50 \mathrm{~g} / 1.75 \mathrm{oz} / 73 \mathrm{~m} / 80 \mathrm{yds}$ )
or Bernat ${ }^{\circledR}$ Satin
( $100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 149 \mathrm{~m} / 163 \mathrm{yds}$ )
XS/S: $570 \mathrm{~m} / 625$ yds
M: $610 \mathrm{~m} / 670 \mathrm{yds}$
L: $735 \mathrm{~m} / 805 \mathrm{yds}$
XL: $854 \mathrm{~m} / 935 \mathrm{yds}$
2/3XL: $980 \mathrm{~m} / 1075$ yds
4/5XL: $1100 \mathrm{~m} / 1205 \mathrm{yds}$
Size 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. 4 st holders. 5 buttons.

## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathbf{2} \boldsymbol{\operatorname { t o g }}=$ Work 2 stitches together (K2tog or Sl1. K1. psso).
Beg $=$ Beginning.
Dec = Decrease(ing).
Inc = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch.
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit.
$\mathbf{K} 2 \boldsymbol{\operatorname { t o g }}=$ Knit next 2 stitches together.
P = Purl.
P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together.
P2togtbl $=$ Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops.
Pat = Pattern.
Psso = Pass slipped stitch over.
Rem = Remaining.
Rep = Repeat.
RS = Right side.
Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise.
St(s) = Stitch (es).
WS = Wrong side.
Yfwd = Yarn forward.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ).

## BACK

Cast on 86 (98-106-118-142-162) sts.
1st row: (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing for 2 ins [ 5 cm ], ending with a 2 nd row and inc 3 ( $\mathbf{1 -}$ 3-2-0-1) st(s) evenly across last row. 89 (99-109-120-142-163) sts.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). (K2. P2) 3 (3-3-4-4-5) times.
Knit to last 12 (12-12-16-16-20) sts. (P2. K2) 3 (3-3-4-4-5) times.
2nd row: (P2. K2) 3 (3-3-4-4-5) times. Purl to last 12 (12-12-16-16-20) sts. (K2. P2) 3 (3-3-4-4-5) times.
Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 8 (9-9-15-16-16) ins [20.5 (23-23-38-40.5$40.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending with a 2 nd row.

Shape raglans: Next row: Cast off 8 (8-8-12-$12-16)$ sts beg of next 2 rows. 73 (83-93-96-118-131) sts.

Sizes XS/S, M and XL only: 1st row: (RS). K2. P2. K2tog. Knit to last 6 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. P2. K2.
Work 3 rows even.
Rep last 4 rows 4 (0-1) time(s) more. 63 (8192) sts.

All sizes: Next row: (RS). K2. P2. K2tog. Knit to last 6 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. P2. K2.
Next row: P2. K2. Purl to last 4 sts. K2. P2.
Rep last 2 rows 3 (12-14-13-9-3) times more.
55 (55-63-64-98-123) sts.

Sizes L, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st row:
(RS). K2. P2. K2tog. Knit to last 6 sts. Sl1.
K1. psso. P2. K2.
2nd row: P2. K2. P2togtbl. Purl to last 6 sts. P2tog. K2. P2.
3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: P2. K2. Purl to last 4 sts. K2. P2.
Rep last 4 rows (0-5-9) times more. (57-62-
63) sts.

Size XL only: Next row: (RS). K2. P2.
K2tog. Knit to last 6 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. P2. K2.
2nd row: P2. K2. P2togtbl. Purl to last 6 sts.
P2tog. K2. P2. 60 sts.
All sizes: Leave rem 55 (55-57-60-62-63) sts on a st holder.

## LEFT FRONT

Cast on 48 (52-56-64-72-84) sts.
1st row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K2. (P1. K1) 3 times.
2nd row: K2. (P1. K1) twice. P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows of ribbing for 2 ins [ 5 cm ], ending with a 2 nd row and dec 2 (0-0-dec 2inc 1-0) st(s) evenly across last row. 46 (52-56-62-73-84) sts.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). (K2. P2) 3 (3-3-4-4-5) times. Knit to last 6 sts. (P1. K1) 3 times.
2nd row: K2. (P1. K1) twice. Purl to last 12
(12-12-16-16-20) sts. (K2. P2) 3 (3-3-4-4-5) times.
Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 8 (9-9-15-16-16) ins [20.5 (23-23-38-40.5$40.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending with a 2 nd row.

Shape raglan: Next row: (RS). Cast off 8 (88 -12-12-16) sts. Pat to end of row. 38 (44-48-50-61-68) sts.
Next row: Work even in pat.
Sizes XS/S, M and XL only: 1st row: (RS). K2. P2. K2tog. Pat to end of row.
Work 3 rows even.
Rep last 4 rows 4 (0-1) time(s) more. 33 (4348) sts.

All sizes: Next row: (RS). K2. P2. K2tog. Pat to end of row.
Next row: Work even in pat.
Rep last 2 rows 3 (12-14-13-9-3) times more. 29 (30-33-34-51-64) sts.

Sizes L, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:
1st row: (RS). K2. P2. K2tog. Pat to end of row. 2nd row: Pat to last 6 sts. P2tog. K2. P2.
3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: Work even in pat.
Rep last 4 rows (0-5-9) times more. (30-3334) sts.

Size XL only: Next row: (RS). K2. P2. K2tog. Pat to end of row.
2nd row: Pat to last 6 sts. P2tog. K2. P2. 32 sts.

All sizes: Leave rem 29 (30-30-32-33-34) sts on a st holder.

Place markers for 5 buttons, having top button at last row, bottom button 6 rows up from cast on edge and rem 3 buttons spaced evenly between.

Work buttonholes on Right Front to correspond to button markers as follows:
Next row: (RS). K1. P1. K1. yfwd. K2tog. Pat to end of row.

## RIGHT FRONT

Cast on 48 (52-56-64-72-84) sts.
1st row: (RS). (K1. P1) 3 times. K2. *P2. K2.
Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 8 sts. P2. (K1. P1) twice. K2.
Rep last 2 rows of ribbing for 2 ins [ 5 cm ], ending with a 2 nd row and dec 2 (0-0-dec 2inc 1-0) evenly across last row. 46 (52-56-62-73-84) sts.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). (K1. P1) 3 times. Knit to last 12 (12-12-16-16-20) sts. (P2. K2) 3 (3-3-4-4-5) times.
2nd row: (P2. K2) 3 (3-3-4-4-5) times. Purl to last 6 sts. (K1. P1) twice. K2.
Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 8 (9-9-15-16-16) ins [20.5 (23-23-38-40.5$40.5) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending with a 1 st row.

Shape raglan: Next row: (WS). Cast off 8 (88 -12-12-16) sts. Pat to end of row. 38 (44-48-50-61-68) sts.

Sizes XS/S, M and XL only: 1st row: (RS). Pat to last 6 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. P2. K2.
Work 3 rows even.
Rep last 4 rows 4 (0-1) time(s) more. 33 (4348) sts.

All sizes: Next row: (RS). Pat to last 6 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. P2. K2.
Next row: Work even in pat.
Rep last 2 rows 3 (12-14-13-9-3) times more. 29 (30-33-34-51-64) sts.

## Sizes L, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

1st row: (RS). Pat to last 6 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. P2. K2.
2nd row: P2. K2. P2togtbl. Pat to end of row. 3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: Work even in pat.
Rep last 4 rows (0-5-9) times more. (30-3334) sts.

Size XL only: Next row: (RS). Pat to last 6 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. P2. K2.
2nd row: P2. K2. P2togtbl. Pat to end of row. 32 sts.

All sizes: Leave rem 29 (30-30-32-33-34) sts on a st holder.

## SLEEVES

Cast on 50 (54-58-62-66-70) sts.
1st row: (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row. Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing, inc 1 st each end of needle on 5th (5th-5th-3rd-3rd3rd) row and every following 8th (6th-6th-4th-2nd-2nd) row to 60 (66-70-66-76-92) sts, taking inc sts into (K2. P2) ribbing.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Inc 1 st each end of needle on every following 4th row from previous inc to $(\mathbf{7 8}-90-100)$ sts.

All sizes: Cont even until work from beg measures $61 / 2$ ins $[16.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending with a WS row.

Shape raglans: Next row: Cast off 8 (8-8-12-12-16) sts beg of next 2 rows. 44 (50-54-54-66-68) sts.
Next row: K2. P2. Work 2tog. Pat to last 6 sts. Work 2tog. P2. K2.
Next 3 rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.
Rep last 4 rows 1 (0-2-5-2-3) time(s). 40 (48-48-42-60-60) sts.

Next row: K2. P2. Work 2tog. Pat to last 6 sts. Work 2tog. P2. K2.
Next row: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.
Rep last 2 rows to 20 (22-26-28-28-28) sts.
Leave rem sts on a st holder.

## FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Neck Edging: Sew raglan seams. Work top buttonhole to correspond to top button marker, AT SAME TIME, with RS of work facing [Pat 27 (28-28-30-31-32) sts. Sl1. K1. psso] from right front st holder.
[K2tog. Pat 16 (18-22-24-24-24) sts. Sl1. K1. psso.] from Right sleeve st holder.
[K2tog. Pat 51 (51-53-56-58-59) sts, inc 1 (dec 1-inc 1-dec 2-dec 2-dec 1) st(s) evenly across. Sl1. K1. psso] from back st holder. [K2tog. Pat 16 (18-22-24-24-24) sts. Sl1. K1. psso.] from Left sleeve st holder. [K2tog. Pat 27 (28-28-30-31-32) sts] from left front st holder. 146 (150-162-170-174-178) sts.
1st row: (WS). K2. (P1. K1) twice. *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 8 sts. P2. (K1. P1) twice. K2. 2nd row: (K1. P1) 3 times. *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 8 sts. K2. (P1. K1) 3 times.
Rep last 2 rows for $11 / 2$ ins [ 4 cm ], ending with 1st row. Cast off in ribbing.

Sew side and sleeve seams.
