Set of 4 sizes U.S. $9(5.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ and U.S. 10 ( 6 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Steel Yarn Needle. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Split-Lock Stitch Count Marker.

## GAUGE

12 sts and 17 rows $=4 "[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stocking st with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## Notes:

- Sweater is worked in one piece, from neck edge down.
- Neck shaping is worked in rows. After center front sts are cast on, work is joined and completed in the round.

With larger circular needle, cast on 36 (38-38-40-44-46) sts.
1st row: (RS). K1. PM. K2. PM. K4 (4-4-4-6-6). PM. K2. PM. K18 (20-20-22-22-24). PM. K2. PM. K4 (4-4-4-6-6). PM. K2. PM. K1.

## 2nd and alt rows: Purl.

3rd row: K1. *M1. SM. K2. SM. M1. K4 (4-4-4-6-6). M1. SM. K2. SM. M1.* Knit to next marker. Rep
from * to * once more. K1. 44 (46-46-48-52-54) sts.
5th row: Knit to first marker. *M1. SM. K2. SM. M1. Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K2. SM. M1.* Knit to next marker. Rep from * to * once more. Knit to end of row. 52 (54-54-56-60-62) sts.
6th row: Purl.
7th row: As 5th row. 60 (62-62-64-68-70) sts.
Next row: (WS). Cast on 16 (18-18-20-20-22) sts (center front). Join to beg working in rnds. 76 (80-80-84-88-92) sts.

Proceed in rnds as follows:
1st rnd: Knit.
2nd rnd: Knit to next marker. *M1. SM. K2. SM. M1.** Knit to next marker. Rep from * twice more, then from * to ${ }^{* *}$ once. Knit to end of rnd. 84 (88-88-92-96100) sts.

Rep last 2 rnds, inc 8 sts every alt rnd 15 (16-19-20-20-21) times more. 204 (216-240-252-256268) sts.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 1st rnd: Knit.
2nd rnd: (Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K2. SM. Knit to next marker.

SM. K2. SM. M1) twice. Knit to end of rnd. (256-260-272) sts.
Rep last 2 rnds, inc 4 sts every alt rnd (1-6-10) time(s) more. (260-284-312) sts.

All sizes: Knit even in rnds on 204 (216-240-260-284-312) sts until work from front neck measures 8 $1 / 22$ (9-10-11-12-13)" [21.5 (23-25.5-28-30.5-33) cm].

Divide for Sleeves and Body: Next rnd: Knit to next marker. Remove marker. K1. Slip next 44 (46-52-52-56-58) sts onto scrap yarn (removing marker). Cast on 2 sts. K58 (62-68-78-8698). Slip next 44 (46-52-52-5658) sts onto scrap yarn (removing marker). Cast on 2 sts. K58 (62-68-78-86-98). 120 (128-140-156-176-200) sts.

## BODY

Knit even in rnds on these 120 (128-140-156-176-200) sts until Body from Sleeve divide measures 12 (12-12-13-13-13)" [30.5 (30.5-30.5-33-33-33) cm].

Change to smaller circular needle and proceed as follows:
Next rnd: *K1tbl. P1. Rep from * around.
Rep last rnd (K1tbl. P1) ribbing for $2 "[5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]. Cast off loosely in pat.

## SLEEVES

Slip 44 (46-52-52-56-58) sts from scrap yarn onto larger doublepointed needles. Pick up and knit 2 sts along armhole divide. PM between last 2 picked up sts. Divide sts among 3 needles to beg working in rnds. 46 (48-54-54-58-60) sts.
Knit even in rnds until work from sleeve divide measures 3 (3-2 $1 / 2$ $21 / 2-1-1)^{\prime \prime} \quad[7.5 \quad(7.5-6.5-6.5-2.5-$ $2.5) \mathrm{cm}]$.

Next rnd: K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. ssk. 44 (46-52-52-56-58) sts. Knit 5 (5-5-5-5-3) rnds even.

Rep last 6 (6-6-6-6-4) rnds 8 (8-2-2-1-10) time(s) more. 28 (28-48-48-54-38) sts.

Sizes L, XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: Next rnd: K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. ssk. (46-46-52-36) sts.
Knit (3-3-3-1) rnd(s) even.
Rep last (4-4-4-2) rnds (8-8-12-3) times more. 30 sts.

All sizes: Cont even until Sleeve measures $14^{\prime \prime}$ [ 35.5 cm ] from armhole divide.
Change to smaller doublepointed needles and proceed as follows:
Next rnd: *K1tbl. P1. Rep from * around.
Rep last rnd of (K1tbl. P1) ribbing for $2^{\prime \prime}[5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
Cast off in pat.
Neckband: With RS facing and smaller circular needle, pick up and knit 36 (38-38-40-44-46) sts along back neck edge. Pick up and knit 8 sts down left front neck edge. Pick up and knit 16 (18-18-20-20-22) sts along front neck edge. Pick up and knit 8 sts up right front neck edge. PM.

Join to beg working in rnds. 68 (72-72-76-80-84) sts.
1st rnd: *K1tbl. P1. Rep from * around.
Rep last rnd (K1tbl. P1) ribbing 6 times more. Cast off in pat.
