# 10. Fading Waves Blanket (to knit)





## **MEASUREMENT**

Approx 36" [91.5 cm] square.

## **GAUGE**

11 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.



### **MATERIALS**

<b>Bernat® Pipsqueak</b> (100 g / 3.5 oz; 109 m / 120 yds)		
	Contrast A (59128 Baby Blue)	3 balls
	Contrast B (59005 Whitey White)	3 balls

OR Bernat<sup>®</sup> Pipsqueak (250 g / 8.8 oz; 274 m / 300 yds)
Contrast A (58128 Baby Blue) 2 balls, Contrast B (58005 Whitey White) 2 balls

Size 5.5 mm (U.S. 9) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 

**STITCH GLOSSARY** 

See page 46 for Helpful Hints. **Approx** = Approximately. **Cont** = Continue(ity).

**K** = Knit.

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together. **Pat** = Pattern.

**Rep** = Repeat.

St(s) = Stitch(es).WS = Wrong side.

**Yo** = Yarn over.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Stripe Pat

With A: 36 rows.

With B: 6 rows.

With A: 18 rows.

With B: 12 rows.

With A: 12 rows.

With B: 18 rows.

With A: 6 rows.

With B: 36 rows.

These 144 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 118 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

With A, knit 5 rows (garter st) noting 1st row is WS.

Proceed in Ripple Pat as follows:

**1st row:** K5. \*(K2tog) 3 times. (yo. K1)

6 times. (K2tog) 3 times. Rep from \* to last

5 sts. K5.

2nd row: K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

3rd row: Knit.

4th and 5th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows.

6th row: As 2nd row.

These 6 rows form Ripple Pat.

First 6 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in Ripple and Stripe Pat until 144 rows

of Stripe Pat are complete.

With B, knit 5 rows (garter st).
Cast off knitwise (WS). BERNAT
