

#### BERNAT LACY CHEVRONS KNIT BABY BLANKET | KNIT



#### **MATERIALS**

**Baby**® **Blanket Dappled**™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m) Skipping Stone (15001) **3 balls or 490 yds/448 m** 

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 40" [101.5 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge.



KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

K = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches

together

**Pat** = Pattern

**Psso** = Pass slipped stitch over

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**SI1** = Slip next stitch knitwise **Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yo** = Yarn over

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 36" x 40" [91.5 x 101.5 cm].

#### **GAUGE**

8 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in **2nd, 4th, 6th, and 8th rows:** stocking stitch.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Cast on 75 sts (multiple of 16 sts + 11). **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Proceed in Lace Pat as follows: See chart on page 2.

## 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 9th rows: (RS). K6. \*yo. K4. ssk. yo. Sl1. K2tog.

psso. yo. K2tog. K4. yo. K1. Rep from \* to last 5 sts. K5.

(WS). K5. Purl to last 5 sts. K5.

10th row: Knit. 11th row: (RS). Knit. 12th row: Knit.

These 12 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 38½" [98 cm], ending on a 9th row.


Knit 5 rows (garter st). Cast off

knitwise.
