

BERNAT THICK VS THIN KNIT BLANKET

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MATERIALS

Bernat® Forever Fleece Finer™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 385 yds/352 m)

Main Color (MC) Splash (76050) 2 balls Contrast A My Sunshine (76003) 1 ball Contrast B White (76052) 1 hall

Size U.S. 10 [6 mm] circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long or size **needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.





ABBREVIATIONS

Cont = Continue(itv) Approx = **RS** = Right side **Approximately Pat** = Pattern **St(s)** = Stitch(es) **Beg** = Beginning Rep = Repeat**WS** = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 40" x 56" [101.5 x 142 cm].

GAUGE

13 stitches (sts) and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch (st).

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Do not carry color at side of work. Break previous color and join new color. Ends will be woven in when Blanket is complete. Blanket is worked side to side (lengthwise).

With MC, cast on 182 sts.

Do not join. Working back and forth across needle, knit 11 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is Wrong Side (WS) and ending on a WS row.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows: With A, work 6 rows garter st. With MC, work 20 rows garter st. With B, work 4 rows garter st. With MC work 22 rows garter st. Last 52 rows form Stripe Pat.

Continue (cont) in Stripe Pat until work from beginning (beg) measures approx 37½" [95 cm], ending with 6 rows of A. Work 15 rows of MC. Cast off knitwise (WS).
