Bernat ${ }^{\circledR}$ Baby Blanket ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ Frosting ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ (10.5 oz/300 g; $220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ ) Golden Hour (61002) 2 balls or $\mathbf{4 4 0}$ yds/402 m
Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 $\mathrm{cm}]$ long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

## MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (Approx) 38" x 44" [ $96.5 \times 112 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## GAUGE

8 sts and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Eyelet Pattern (Pat).

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Blanket is reversible. There is no right or wrong side.


Cast on 72 stitches (sts) (multiple of 3 sts). Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
1st row: *Knit 1 (K1). Yarn over (yo). Knit next 2 stitches together (K2tog). Repeat (Rep) from * to end of row.
Rep last row for Easy Eyelet Pat until work from beginning (beg) measures 44 " $[112 \mathrm{~cm}]$. Cast off.
