



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dcfp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Dcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Pat** = Pattern

**PM** = Place marker

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sl st(s)** = Slip stitch(es)

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**WS** = Wrong side

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 15" [38 cm] wide x 24" [61 cm] deep, excluding hood.

## GAUGE

9 sc and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

**Ribbing:** Ch 20.

**1st row:** (RS). Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 19 sts.

**2nd to 4th rows:** Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, sl st in each st to end of row. Turn.

**\*\*5th row:** (RS). (Buttonhole row). Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, sl st in each of next 9 sl sts. Ch 2. Skip next 2 sl sts. *Working in back loops only*, sl st in each sl st to end of row. Turn.

## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Baby Marly™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 221 yds/202 m)

Soft Breeze (33007)

**3 balls**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
Stitch markers. 10 buttons 1" [2.5 cm] diameter.

**6th row:** Ch 1. Working in back loops only, sl st in each sl st to end of row, working sl st in each of 2 ch. Turn.\*\*

**7th row:** Ch 1. Working in back loops only, sl st in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work when slightly stretched, measures 14" [35.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Rep 5th and 6th rows from \*\* to \*\*.

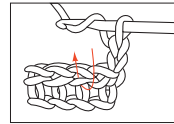
Rep 7th row 4 times more. **Do not** turn.

Proceed across side edge of Ribbing as follows:

**Body: 1st row:** (RS). Ch 2. Work 36 hdc across long side of Ribbing. PM at each end of row (first set of markers).

**2nd row:** Ch 2. \*Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row on WS of work (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – see diagram). Rep from \* 4 times more. (1 dcbp around each of next 2 sts. 1 dcbp around each of next 6 sts) 3 times. 1 dcbp around each of next 2 sts. \*\*Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row on WS of work (bar is below loops normally

worked on WS). Rep from \*\* 4 times more. Turn.



**3rd row:** Ch 2. \*Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row on WS of work. Rep from \* 4 times more. (1 dcbp around each of next 2 sts. 1 dcbp around each of next 6 sts) 3 times. 1 dcbp around each of next 2 sts. \*\*Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row on WS of work (bar is below loops normally worked on WS). Rep from \*\* 4 times more. Turn.

**4th row:** As 2nd row. Last 2 rows form Vertical Ridges Pat.

Cont in Vertical Ridges Pat as follows:

**5th row:** (RS). (Buttonhole row). Ch 2. (Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row on WS of work) twice. Ch 2. Skip next 2 hdc. Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row on WS of work. (1 dcbp around each of next 2 sts. 1 dcbp around each of next 6 sts) 3 times. 1 dcbp around

each of next 2 sts. Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row on WS of work. Ch 2. Skip next 2 hdc. (Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below st in previous row on WS of work) twice. Turn.

**6th row:** Work in pat, working 2 hdc in each ch-2 sp.\*\*\*\* Work 6 rows even in pat.\*\*\* Rep from \*\*\* to \*\*\* 3 times more, then from \*\*\* to \*\*\*\* once.

Cont even in pat until work from first set of markers measures 24" [61 cm], ending on WS row. PM at each end of last row (2nd set of markers).

Cont even in pat until work from 2nd set of markers measures 24" [61 cm], ending on WS row. PM at each end of last row (3rd set of markers).

Cont even in pat until work from 3rd set of markers measures 8" [20.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Fold work along 2nd set of markers for Front. Sew buttons to correspond to buttonholes on WS of Back. Fold Ribbing to RS and match buttonholes with first row of buttonholes of Body. Fold 2 corners before first set of markers to form hood (see diagram on page 3). Sew hood center seam. Sew on buttons to correspond to buttonholes.
