

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Softee ${ }^{\oplus}$ Baby ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( 5 oz/ $140 \mathrm{~g} ; 362 \mathrm{yds} / 331 \mathrm{~m}$ )
White (02000)

## 1 ball

or Pink (02001), Pale Blue (02002), Lemon (02003), Mint (02004). One ball makes 6(5) hats.
Size U.S. 5 ( 3.75 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{T M}$ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Steel Yarn Needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing)
Beg $=$ Begin(ning)
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit
K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches
together
Pat $=$ Pattern
RS $=$ Right side
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep $=$ Repeat
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yo = Yarn over

## SIZES

To fit Preemie ( $6 / 12$ mos-18 mos).

## GAUGE

24 sts and 32 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

Cast on 74 (86-86) sts.
Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.
Continue in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd and 4th rows: As 1st and 2nd rows.

5th row: K1. *(K2tog) twice. (Yo. K1) 4 times. (K2tog) twice. Rep from * to last st. K1.
6th row: Knit.
These 6 rows form Feather and Fan pat.

Continue in pat for 18 (24-24) rows more, ending on a 6th row of pat. Continue in stocking st until work from beg measures 4 (41/25)" [10 (11.5-12.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

## Shape Top

1st row: (RS). K1. *K2tog. K10 (5-10). Rep from * to last st. K1. 68 (74-79) sts rem.
2nd and alt rows: Purl.

3rd row: K1. *K2tog. K9 (10-9).
Rep from * to last st. K1. 62 (6872) sts rem.

5th row: K1. *K2tog. K8 (9-8). Rep from * to last st. K1. 56 (62-65) sts rem.
7th row: K1. *K2tog. K7 (8-7). Rep from * to last st. K1. 50 (56-58) sts rem.
9th row: K1. *K2tog. K6 (7-6). Rep from * to last st. K1. 44 (50-51) sts rem.
11th row: K1. *K2tog. K5 (4-5).
Rep from * to last st. K1. 38 (42-44) sts rem.
13th row: K1. *K2tog. Rep from * to last st. K1. 20 (22-23) sts rem.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew back seam.
