MATERIALS

Bernat[®] Softee[®] Baby[™] (5 oz/140 g; 362 yds/331 m)

White (02000)

1 ball

or Pink (02001), Pale Blue (02002), Lemon (02003), Mint (02004). One ball makes 6(5) hats.

Size U.S. 5 (3.75 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume™ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® Steel Yarn Needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing) Beg = Begin(ning)

 $\mathbf{K} = Knit$

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together

Pat = Pattern

RS = Right side

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over

SIZES

To fit Preemie (6/12 mos-18 mos).

GAUGE

24 sts and 32 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ().

Cast on 74 (86-86) sts.

Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Continue in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). Knit. 2nd row: Purl.

3rd and 4th rows: As 1st and 2nd

rows.

5th row: K1. *(K2tog) twice. (Yo. K1) 4 times. (K2tog) twice. Rep from * to last st. K1.

6th row: Knit.

These 6 rows form Feather and Fan pat.

Continue in pat for 18 (24-24) rows more, ending on a 6th row of pat. Continue in stocking st until work from beg measures 4 (41/2-5)" [10 (11.5-12.5) cm], ending on a purl row.

Shape Top

1st row: (RS). K1. *K2tog. K10 (5-10). Rep from * to last st. K1. 68 (74-79) sts rem.

2nd and alt rows: Purl.



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3rd row: K1. *K2tog. K**9** (10-9). Rep from * to last st. K1. **62** (68-72) sts rem.

5th row: K1. *K2tog. K8 (9-8). Rep from * to last st. K1. **56** (**62-65**) sts rem.

7th row: K1. *K2tog. K**7** (8-7). Rep from * to last st. K1. **50** (56-58) sts rem.

9th row: K1. *K2tog. K6 (7-6). Rep from * to last st. K1. **44** (50-51) sts rem.

11th row: K1. *K2tog. K**5** (**4-5**). Rep from * to last st. K1. **38** (**42-44**) sts rem.

13th row: K1. *K2tog. Rep from * to last st. K1. **20** (22-23) sts rem.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew back seam.
