## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Baby Sport ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $12.3 \mathrm{oz} / 350 \mathrm{~g} / 1256 \mathrm{yds} / 1148 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Sizes $\quad$ Preemie Newborn $3 / 6$ mos $6 / 12 \quad 18 / 24$ mos
Baby Pink (21420) or Peach Blossom (21510) or Baby Yellow (21615) or Baby Green (21230) or Lilac (21319)
Note: 1 ball will make approx 30 (28-25-17-13) Hats.
Set of 4 sizes U.S. 5 ( 3.75 mm ) and U.S. 6 ( 4 mm ) double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

## SIZES

## To fit head circumference

Preemie $93 / 4-101 / 2^{\prime \prime}[25-26.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]
Newborn 11-12" [28-30.5 cm]
$3 / 6 \mathrm{mos} \quad 13-14^{\prime \prime}[33-35.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$
$6 / 12 \mathrm{mos} \quad 15-16^{\prime \prime}[38-40.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$
$18 / 24$ mos $17-18$ " [43-45.5 cm]

## GAUGE

22 sts and 30 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger needles in stocking stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

With smaller needles, cast on 48 (56-64-80-88) sts. Divide onto 3 needles and join for working in rnd, placing marker on first st.

1st rnd: Knit.
2nd rnd: Purl.
Rep last 2 rnds for 1 ( $11 / 2-13 / 4$ -$2-21 / 4$ )" [2.5 (4-4.5-5-5.5) cm], ending on a 1 st rnd.

## '̌arnspirations"

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Change to larger set of needles and proceed in Spiral Rib Pat as follows:
1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.
2nd rnd: *K1. P2. K1. Rep from * around.
3rd rnd: *P2. K2. Rep from * around.
4th rnd: *P1. K2. P1. Rep from * around.
Rep last 4 rnds 2 (3-4-6-7) times more.

Shape top: 1st rnd: *K2. P2tog. K2. P2. Rep from ${ }^{*}$ around. 42 (49-56-70-77) sts.
2nd rnd: *K1. P1. K2. P2. K1. Rep from * around.
3rd rnd: *P1. K2. P2tog. K2. Rep from * around. 36 (42-48-60-66) sts. 4th rnd: *K2. P1. Rep from * around.
5th rnd: *K1. P1. K2tog. P1. K1. Rep from * around. 30 (35-40-5055) sts.

6th rnd: *P1. K1. P1. K2. Rep from * around.

7th rnd: *K1. P1. K2tog. P1. Rep from * around. 24 (28-32-40-44) sts. 8th rnd: *P1. K1. Rep from * around.

9th rnd: *K2tog. K1. P1. Rep from * around. 18 (21-24-30-33) sts. 10th rnd: *K1. P1. K1. Rep from * around.
11th rnd: *P2tog. K1. Rep from * around. 12 (14-16-20-22) sts.
12th rnd: *K2tog. Rep from * around. 6 (7-8-10-11) sts.
13th rnd: (K2tog) 2 (3-4-5-5) times. K2 (1-0-0-1). 4 (4-4-5-6) sts.

Sizes $3 / 6$ and $6 / 12$ mos only: 14th rnd: (K2tog) 1 (2) time(s). K3 (2). 4 sts.

All sizes: With 4 sts on 1 doublepointed needle and working yarn at left, knit i-cord with pair of double-pointed needles as follows:
1st row: K4. Do not turn. Slide sts to opposite end of needle.
Rep last row until i-cord measures 3" [7.5 cm]. Break yarn. Draw end tightly through all sts. Tie cord in knot as seen in picture.
