Size U.S. 6 ( 4 mm ) circular knitting needle $29^{\prime \prime}[74 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long. Size U.S. $6(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ knitting needles for Sleeves or size needed to obtain gauge. 2 stitch holders. Cable needle. 8 stitch markers. 1 button.

6 mos 17 " $[43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]
$12 \mathrm{mos} 18^{\prime \prime}[45.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$
$18 \mathrm{mos} \quad 19$ " $[48 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## Finished chest

## GAUGE

20 sts and 40 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Garter St.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: Body is worked in one piece to armholes. Sleeves are worked flat, joined onto Body and Yoke is worked in one piece.

Lace Panel (worked over 7 sts)
1st row: (RS). Cr3B. K1. Cr3F.
2nd and 4th rows: P7.
3rd row: K1.K2tog. yo. K1. yo. ssk. K1.
5th row: As 3rd row.
6th row: Purl.
These 6 rows form Lace Panel Pat.

## BODY

With $B$ and circular needle, cast on 110 (114-120) sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Work $11 / 2$ " $[4.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter st (knit every row), noting first row is WS and ending on a WS row. Break B. With A , cont in garter st until work from beg measures $61 / 2(7-71 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ [16.5 (18-19.5) cm], ending on a WS row. Leave sts on needle.

## SLEEVES

With B and pair of needles, cast on 38 (40-42) sts.
Work $11 / 2$ " $[4.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in garter st (knit every row), noting first row is WS and ending on a WS row. Break B. With $A$, cont in garter st for 8 rows.

Inc 1 st each end of next row and following 8th rows until there are 42 (46-50) sts.
Cont even work from beg measures 7 ( $71 / 2-8$ )" [18 (19-20.5) cm ], ending on a WS row. Leave sts on st holder.

## YOKE

1st row: (RS). With A and circular needle, K28 (29-31) (Right Front) from Body. K42 (46-50) from Sleeve. K54 (56-58) (Back) from Body. K42 (46-50) from Sleeve. K28 (29-31) (Left Front) from Body. 194 (206-220) sts.
2nd row: (Set-up row-WS). K25 (26-28). PM. P7. PM. K34 (3842). PM. P7. PM. K48 (50-52). PM. P7. PM. K34 (38-42). PM. P7. PM. K25 (26-28).
3rd row: K23 (24-26). ssk. SM. Work 1st row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K2tog. K30 (34-38). ssk. SM. Work 1st row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K2tog. K44 (46-48). ssk. SM. Work 1st row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K2tog. K30 (34-38). ssk. SM. Work 1st row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K2tog. K23 (24-26). 186 (198-212) sts.

4th row: K24 (25-27). SM. Work 2nd row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K32 (36-40). SM. Work 2nd row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K46 (48-50). SM. Work 2nd row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K32 (3640). SM. Work 2nd row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K24 (25-27).
5th row: K24 (25-27). SM. Work 3rd row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K32 (36-40). SM. Work 3rd row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K46 (48-50). SM. Work 3rd row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K32 (36-40). SM. Work 3rd row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K24 (25-27). 6th row: K24 (25-27). SM. Work 4th row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K32 (36-40). SM. Work 4th row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K46 (48-50). SM. Work 4th row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K32 (36-40). SM. Work 4th row of Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K24 (25-27). Lace Panel Pat is now in position.
7th row (Dec row): Knit to 2 sts before next marker. ssk. *SM. Work Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K2tog. Knit to 2 sts before next
marker. ssk. Rep from * twice more. SM. Work Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K2tog. Knit to end of row. (8 sts dec).
Keeping markers in place for rem of Yoke, work 3 rows even in pat. Rep Dec row on next row and following 4th rows 1 (3-5) time(s) more. 162 (158-156) sts. Work 1 row even in pat. Rep Dec row on next row and following alt rows 10 (9-8) times more. 74 (78-84) sts. Work 1 row even in pat.
Next row: (Buttonhole row - RS): K3. Cast off 2 sts. Knit to 2 sts before next marker. ssk. *SM. Work Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K2tog. Knit to 2 sts before next marker. ssk. Rep from * twice more. SM. Work Lace Panel Pat across next 7 sts. SM. K2tog. Knit to end of row.
Work 1 row even in pat, casting on 2 sts over cast off sts.
Rep Dec row on next row. 58 (62-68) sts.
Cast off all sts knitwise (WS).

## FINISHING

Sew sleeve seams. Sew button in position to correspond to buttonhole.
