## Sizes

Baby Grey (21048) 1
Note: 1 ball makes 3 (2-2) Sets.
Size U.S. 6 ( 4 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle 29" [ 73.6 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. 8 stitch markers. 2 stitch holders. 3 buttons.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt $=$ Alternate
Approx = Approximate(ly)
Beg $=\operatorname{Begin}($ ning $)$
K = Knit
K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together
$\mathbf{K f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back loop of next stitch
M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop

## GAUGE

20 sts and 38 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter st.
$\mathbf{P}=$ Purl
PM = Place marker
Psso $=$ Pass slipped stitch over
Rem = Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
SI1 = Slip next stitch knitways
SM = Slip marker
Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS $=$ Wrong side

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smaller size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to both sizes.

Note: Cardigan is worked in one piece from neck edge down. Slip markers as you work.

Beg at neck edge, cast on 52 (5660) sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
Neckband: Knit 7 rows (garter st) noting first row is WS.

1st row: (RS). K8 (9-10). M1. PM. K2. PM. M1. K6. M1. PM. K2. PM. M1. K16 (18-20). M1. PM. K2. PM. M1. K6. M1. PM. K2. PM. M1. K8 (9-10). 60 (64-68) sts.
2nd row: (Knit to marker. SM. P2. SM.) 4 times. Knit to end of row.
3rd row: (Knit to next marker. M1. SM. K2. SM. M1) 4 times. Knit to end of row. 68 (72-76) sts.
Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 10 (11-11) times more. 148 (160-164) sts.

1st row: (WS). (Knit to next marker. P2) 4 times. Knit to end of row.
2nd row: (Knit to next marker. K2) 4 times. Knit to end of row.
3rd row: As 1st row.
4th row: (Knit to next marker. M1.
SM. K2. SM. M1) 4 times. Knit to end of row.
Rep last 4 rows 1 (1-2) time(s) more. 164 (176-188) sts.
Next row: (WS). (Knit to next marker. P2) 4 times. Knit to end of row.

Divide Sleeves and Body: Next row: (RS). K22 (24-26). Slip next 38 (40-42) sts for Sleeve onto st holder. K44 (48-52). Slip next 38 (40-42) sts for Sleeve onto st holder. K22 (24-26). 88 (96-104) sts for Body.

Cont in Garter St until Body from Sleeve divide measures 5 (6-7)" [12.5 (15-18) cm], ending on a RS row.
Cast off knitwise (WS).
Sleeves: With RS facing, rejoin yarn to 38 (40-42) Sleeve sts.
Cont in Garter St until work from Body divide measures 4½ (5½-6)" [11.5 (14-15) cm], ending on a RS row.
Cast off knitways (WS).
Sew sleeve seam.
Button Band: Pick up and knit 45 (51-57) sts evenly down left front edge.
Knit 6 rows (garter st).
Cast off knitways (WS).
Place markers on this band for 3 buttons having top button $1 / 2$ " $[1 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] below neck edge, bottom button 4 " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ below top button and rem button centered between.

Buttonhole Band: Pick up and knit 45 (51-57) sts evenly up right front edge.

## Knit 3 rows (garter st).

Next row: (RS). (Knit to next button marker. K2tog. yo) 3 times. Knit to end of row.

## Next 2 rows: Knit.

Cast off knitways (WS). Sew on buttons to correspond to buttonholes.

## HAT

Cast on 51 (59-69) sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: 1st row: (RS). K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row. P1.
Rep last 2 rows twice more (6 rows total).
Knit in rows (garter st) until work from beg measures $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2(3-31 / 2)$ " [6 $(7.5-9) \mathrm{cm}]$, ending on a WS row.

Shape top: 1 st row: (RS). *K23 (1232). K2tog. Rep from * to last 1 (3-1) st(s). K1 (3-1). 49 (55-67) sts.
2nd and alt rows: Knit.
3rd row: K1. *K2tog. K6 (7-9). Rep from * to end of row. 43 (49-61) sts. 5th row: K1. *K2tog. K5 (6-8). Rep from * to end of row. 37 (43-55) sts. 7th row: K1. *K2tog. K4 (5-7). Rep from * to end of row. 31 (37-49) sts. 9th row: K1. *K2tog. K3 (4-6). Rep from * to end of row. 25 (31-43) sts. 11th row: K1. *K2tog. K2 (3-5). Rep from * to end of row. 19 (25-37) sts. 13th row: K1. *K2tog. K1 (2-4). Rep from * to end of row. 13 (19-31) sts.

Sizes 3 mos and 6/12 mos only: 14th row: Knit.
15th row: K1. *K2tog. K (1-3). Rep from * to end of row. (13-25) sts.

Size 6/12 mos only: 16th row: Knit.
17th row: K1. *K2tog. K2. Rep from * to end of row. 19 sts.

All sizes: Next row: K1. *K2tog.
Rep from * to end of row. 7 (7-9) sts. Break yarn leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts.
Sew center back seam.

Ears (make 2)
Cast on 5 sts.
1st row: K5.
2nd row: (Kfb) 4 times. K1. 9 sts. Knit in rows (garter st) until Ear measures 3 ( $31 / 2-31 / 2$ )" [7.5 (9-9) cm].

Shape tip: 1 st row: K1. K2tog. K3. ssk. K1. 7 sts.
2nd row: Knit.
3rd row: K1. K2tog. K1. ssk. K1. 5 sts.
4th row: Knit.
5th row: K1. Sl1. K2tog. psso. K1. 3 sts.
6th row: Knit.
7th row: SI1. K2tog. psso. Fasten off.
Fold cast on edge in half and sew Ears in position to Hat as shown in photo.
