COUNTRY MOUSE VERSION

CITY MOUSE VERSION

MATERIALS

Bernat® Softee® Baby Chunky™ (5 oz/140 g; 155 yds/142 m)

Country Mouse Version

- Contrast A** Cream Puff (96006) **3 balls**
- Contrast B** Cozy Gray (96005) **3 balls**
- Contrast C** Teddy Brown (96016) **1 ball**

City Mouse Version

- Contrast A** Sprout Green (96010) **3 balls**
- Contrast B** Blue Lagoon (96011) **3 balls**
- Contrast C** Cozy Gray (96005) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**



KNIT 1 SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

- Approx** = Approximately
- Beg** = Beginning
- Cont** = Continue(ity)
- K** = Knit
- K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together
- Pat** = Pattern
- PssO** = Pass slipped stitch over
- Rep** = Repeat

- RS** = Right side
- Sl1** = Slip next stitch knitwise
- Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through the back loops together.
- St(s)** = Stitch(es)
- WS** = Wrong side
- Yo** = Yarn over

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 39" x 45" [99 x 114.5 cm]

GAUGE

11 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat:

- With A, work 10 rows.
- With B, work 6 rows.
- With C, work 2 rows.
- With A, work 14 rows.
- With B, work 4 rows.
- With C, work 2 rows.
- With B, work 12 rows.
- With A, work 2 rows.
- With C, work 4 rows.
- With A, work 4 rows.
- With B, work 6 rows.

These 66 rows form Stripe Pat. With A, cast on 143 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, knit 1 row.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). K1. K2tog. *K8. (K1. yo. K1) in next st. K8. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. Rep from * 5 times more. K8. (K1. yo. K1) in next st. K8. ssk. K1.

2nd row: Knit. Last 2 rows form Zig Zag Garter St Pat. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Cont in pat, keeping cont of Stripe Pat, until work from beg along side edge measures 45" [114.5 cm], ending on a RS row.

With appropriate color, cast off knitwise (WS).
