



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue

Dec = Decreas(e)(ing)

Inc = Inceas(e)(ing)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

PM = Place marker

Pssso = Pass slipped stitch over

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

SI1K = Slip next stitch knitwise

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over

MEASUREMENT

Approx 39" [99 cm] square.

GAUGE

9 sts and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Due to the high pile of Bernat® Sheepy™ yarn, you may find it useful to place a safety pin or stitch marker on the RS of work to help keep better track.

With A, cast on 2 sts,

1st row: (RS). K1. yo. K1. 3 sts.

2nd row: K1. yo. K2. 4 sts.

3rd row: K1. yo. K3. 5 sts.

4th row: K1. yo. Knit to end of row. Rep last row, inc 1 st at beg of every row until work measures 29" [73.5 cm] along straight side edge, ending on a WS row.

Break A. Join B.

With B, cont as established, inc 1 st at beg of every row for a further 10" [25.5 cm], ending on a WS row. (Work now measures 39" [99 cm] along straight side edge). PM at end of row.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Sheepy™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 149 yds/136 m)

Contrast A Vapor Gray (43010) **1 ball**

Contrast B Bunny Brown (43003) **1 ball**

Contrast C Cotton Tail (43001) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

Beg decreases: 1st row: (RS). ssk.
yo. ssk. Knit to end of row.
Rep last row, dec 1 st at beg of
every row until work measures 10"
[25.5 cm] from marked row, ending
on a WS row.
Break B. Join C.

With C, cont as established, dec
1 st at beg of every row until 3 sts
rem.

Next row: Sl1K. K2tog. pssso.
Break yarn, draw end through
rem st and pull up tightly. Fasten
securely.
