

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Forever Fleece Finer ${ }^{\text {rm }}$ ( $9.9 \mathrm{oz} / 280 \mathrm{~g} ; 385 \mathrm{yds} / 352 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A White Cloud (76011) 1 ball
Contrast B Zing (76016) 1 ball
Contrast C My Sunshine (76003) 1 ball
Contrast D Pebble (76013) 1 ball
Contrast E Petunia (76009) 1 ball
Size U.S. $10(6 \mathrm{~mm})$ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. T-pins $13 / 4$ " $[4.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ long. Yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt $=$ Alternate
Approx = Approximately
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS = Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 43" [109 cm] square.

## GAUGES

13 sts and 26 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in garter st.
Block = Approx 83/4" [22 cm] square.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## HORIZONTAL BLOCKS

2 with D as Color 1 and A as Color 2. 1 with E as Color 1 and D as Color 2. 1 with D as Color 1 and B as Color 2. 2 with E as Color 1 and B as Color 2. 1 with D as Color 1 and E as Color 2. 2 with E as Color 1 and A as Color 2. 1 with A as Color 1 and B as Color 2. 1 with E as Color 1 and C as Color 2. 1 with B as Color 1 and E as Color 2. 1 with C as Color 1 and A as Color 2.

## First Wedge

With Color 1, cast on 28 sts using 2 needle cable cast-on method.
Foundation row: (WS). With Color 1, knit.
**1st row: (RS). K24. W\&T.
2nd and alt (WS) rows: Knit.
3rd row: K20. W\&T.
5th row: K16. W\&T.
7th row: K12. W\&T.
9th row: K8. W\&T.
11th row: K4. W\&T.
12th row: (WS). K4. Join Color 2.
Second Wedge: 1st row: (RS). With Color 2, knit across all sts (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would).
2nd row: K24. W\&T.
3rd and alt (RS) rows: Knit.
4th row: K20. W\&T.
6th row: K16. W\&T.
8th row: K12. W\&T
10th row: K8. W\&T.
12th row: K4. W\&T.
14th row: (WS). Knit across all sts (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would)..** Join Color 1. 15th and 16th rows:With Color 1, knit.**

Rep from ** to ** once more, then from ** to *** once. (6 Wedges). With Color 2, cast off all sts.

## VERTICAL BLOCKS

2 with C as Color 1 and B as Color 2. 2 with B as Color 1 and E as Color 2. 2 with D as Color 1 and $A$ as Color 2. 2 with C as Color 1 and D as Color 2. 1 with C as Color 1 and E as Color 2. 2 with D as Color 1 and B as Color 2. 1 with D as Color 1 and C as Color 2.

## First Wedge

With Color 1 , cast on 28 sts using 2 needle cable cast-on method.
**1 st row: (WS). K24. W\&T.
2nd and alt (RS) rows: Knit.
3rd row: K20. W\&T.
5th row: K16. W\&T.
7th row: K12. W\&T.
9th row: K8. W\&T.
11th row: K4. W\&T.
13th row: (WS). Knit across all sts (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would). Break Color 1. Join Color 2.

Second Wedge: 1 st and 2nd rows: With Color 2, knit. 3rd row: (RS). K24. W\&T.
4th and alt (WS) rows: Knit.
5th row: K20. W\&T.
7th row: K16. W\&T.
9th row: K12.W\&T.
11th row: K8. W\&T.
13th row: K4. W\&T.
14th row: K4.*** Break Color 2. Join Color 1.
15th row: (RS). With Color 1, knit across all sts (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would).**

Rep from ** to ** once more, then from ** to *** once. (6 Wedges). With Color 2, cast off all sts.

## FINISHING

Pin each Block onto a flat surface to measure $83 / 4$ " [22 cm] square. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.
Following Diagram, pin Blocks tog adjusting Blocks to straighten as needed. Sew Blocks tog with flat seams.
