FINGER KNITTIN' GOOD SCARF | Craft





MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 2" [5 cm] wide x 48" [122 cm] long.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Super Value™ (197 g/7 oz; 389 m/426 yds)



Contrast A Peacock (00616) 1 ball



Contrast B Teal Heather (53203) 1 ball



Contrast C Aqua (53201) 1 ball

Scissors. Blunt-tipped tapestry needle. Adhesive tape.

INSTRUCTIONS

Make 3 Scarf Lengths

(1 each in Contrast A, B and C).

Step 1

Leaving approximately 6" [15 cm] tail, lay the yarn across your left-hand palm.



Step 2

Using your right hand, wrap yarn clockwise around your left-hand index finger.



Step 3

Repeating as in Step 2, wrap the yarn clockwise around your middle, ring, and pinky fingers. You'll now have loops on all fingers, excluding the thumb.



Step 4

Lay the yarn across your fingers, above the loops.



Step 5

Lift your pinky finger loop over the yarn, and let it drop off your finger.

Step 6

Repeating as in Step 5, lift the loop over the yarn and let it drop off the ring, middle, and pointer fingers. You've just completed your first row!



Step 7: Repeat Steps 4–6 until your finger-knitted cord is 48" [122 cm] long. Keep in mind that at the end of each row the yarn end will be on the opposite side of the palm. Simply lay the yarn across your palm, beginning from whichever direction the yarn is oriented.

To finish off, cut the yarn, leaving a 6" [15 cm] tail. Using tapestry needle, weave the tail through loops, letting them fall off your fingers. Pull tight and knot. That's all there is to it!

FINISHING

Step 1: Tape the ends of all 3 Scarf Lengths together onto a table or the floor.

Step 2: Braid the Scarf Lengths together.

Step 3: Using tapestry needle and a strand of any color yarn, sew an "X" at either end of the braid to tack the Scarf Length pieces together. Trim yarn ends.
