## GAUGE

11 sts and 14 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger needles in stocking st.

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\text {Softee }}{ }^{\circ}$ Chunky $^{\text {m" }}$
( $100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5 \mathrm{oz} ; 99 \mathrm{~m} / 108 \mathrm{yds}$ )

Sizes 6.5 mm (U.S. $10 \frac{1}{2}$ ) and 8 mm (U.S. 11) circular knitting needles 24 " 60 cm ] long. Set of four sizes 6.5 mm (U.S. $101 / 2$ ) and 8 mm (U.S. 11) double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Separating zipper 16 (16-18-20-20-22)" [40 (40-45-50-50-55) cm] long. 5 st holders.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: Body is worked in one piece to armholes.

## BODY

With MC and smaller circular needle, cast on 71 (79-81-87-93-99) sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row. Rep last 2 rows of (K1.P1) ribbing for 2" [ 5 cm ], ending with a 2 nd row and inc 1 st at center of last row. 72 (80-82-88-94-100) sts.

Change to larger circular needle and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures 10 (11-12-13-14-15)" [25.5 (28-30.5-33-35.538) cm ], ending with a purl row.

Divide for Fronts and Back: K19 (21-22-23-
26-27) for Right Front. Slip last 2 (2-2-2-4-4) sts onto a st holder. K36 (40-40-44-46-50) for Back (including st on needle after cast off). Slip last 2 (2-2-2-4-4) sts onto a st holder. K17 (19-20-21-22-23) for Left Front. Leave all sts on a spare needle.

## SLEEVES

With MC and smaller double-pointed needles, cast on 22 (22-22-22-22-26) sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd, placing a marker on first st. 1st rnd: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.
Rep last rnd of (K1. P1) ribbing for $21 / 2$ " $[6 \mathrm{~cm}]$, inc 0 (0-0-2-2-0) sts evenly across last rnd.
22 (22-22-24-24-26) sts.
Change to larger double-pointed needles and knit in rnds, inc 1 st at beg and end of needle on next and every following 4th (4th-4th-4th-4th-6th) rnd until there are 28 (28-30-30-$30-38$ ) sts, then every following 6th (6th-6th-6th-6th-8th) rnd until there are 30 (32-34-36-38-40) sts.

Cont even until work from beg measures $71 / 2$ ( $91 / 2-101 / 2-111 / 2-121 / 2-14$ )" [19 (24-26.5-29-32$35.5) \mathrm{cm}]$.

## BERNLAL

## Softee

Next row: K1 (1-1-1-2-2). Slip these st(s) onto a st holder. K28 (30-32-34-34-36). Slip last 1 (1-1-$1-2-2) \mathrm{st}(\mathrm{s})$ onto a st holder. Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

## YOKE

With RS facing, MC and larger circular needle, K17 (19-20-21-22-23) of Right Front, K28 (30-32-34-34-36) of right Sleeve, K34 (38-38-42-42-46) of Back, K28 (30-32-34-34-36) of right Sleeve, K17 (19-20-21-22-23) of Left Front. 124 (136-142-152-154-164) sts.
Purl one row.
Next rnd: With MC, K2 (0-0-0-0-0). [K15 (17-71-38-77-41). M1] 8 (8-2-4-2-4) times. K2 (0-0-0-0-0). 132 (144-144-156-156-168) sts.

Note: When working from charts, carry yarn not in use loosely across WS of work, but never over more than 4 sts. When it must pass over more than 4 sts, weave it over and under center point of sts its being passed over. The colors are never twisted around one another.

Work Chart II (|-|-|-|||-||) in stocking st to end of chart, reading knit rows from right to left and purl rows from left to right, noting 12-st rep will be worked 11 (12-12-13-13-14) times. 55 (60-60-65-65-70) sts.

Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). With MC, K3. Slip these 3 sts onto a st holder. K1 (2-2-1-1-3). [K2tog. K7 (5-5-6-6-6)] 5 (7-7-7-7-7) times. K2tog. Knit to end of row. 46 (49-49-54-54-59) sts.
2nd row: Slip first 3 sts onto a st holder. Rejoin MC to next st and purl to end of row. 43 (46-46-51-51-56) sts.
3rd row: ssk. K1 (3-3-2-2-1). [K2tog. K5 (3-3-4-4-5)] 5 (7-7-7-7-7) times. K2tog. K1 (2-2-1-1-0). K2tog. 35 (36-36-41-41-46) sts.
4th row: P2tog. Purl to last 2 sts. P2togtbl. 33 (34-34-39-39-44) sts.
5th row: ssk. K1 (2-2-2-2-2). [K2tog. K3 (3-3-4-4-5)] 5 times. K2tog. K1. K2tog. 25 (26-26-31-31-36) sts.

Size 12 only: 6th row: Purl.
7th row: K2. (K2tog. K4) 5 times. K2tog. K2. 30 sts.
All sizes: Next row: Purl. Leave rem sts on a st holder.

## FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry. Graft underarm seams.


Neckband: With RS facing, MC and smaller circular needle, K3 from front st holder. Pick up and knit 6 (8-8-8-8-10) sts up right front neck edge. K25 (26-26-31-31-30) from st holder, dec 0 (1-1-0-0-1) st at center of back. Pick up and knit 6 (8-8-8-8-10) sts down left front neck edge. K3 from front st holder. 43 (45-45-51-51-55) sts.
1st row: (WS). K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.
2nd row: P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row. Rep last 2 rows twice more. Cast off in ribbing.

Zipper edging: With RS facing, MC and smaller circular needle, pick up and knit 46 (50-56-58-64-68) sts evenly up front edge. Cast off. Rep for other side.

Finishing: Sew zipper in position.
