## GAUGE

17 sts and 32 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 17 sts.
Foundation Rectangle: 1st row: SI1Pwyif. yb. Knit to end of row.
Rep last row 31 times more. (You will have 16 'chains' along either side edge, which will make for easier picking up along these edges later).
**Turn corner: First Half: 1st row: With A, SI1Pwyif. yb. K15. Turn.
2nd and alt rows: SI1Pwyif. yb. Knit to end of row.
3rd row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K14. Turn.
5th row: Sl1Pwyif. yb. K13. Turn.
7th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K12. Turn.
9th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K11.Turn.
11th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K10. Turn.
13th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K9. Turn.
15th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K8. Turn.
17th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K7. Turn.
19th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K6. Turn.
21st row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K5. Turn.

23rd row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K4. Turn.
25th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K3. Turn.
27th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K2. Turn.
29th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K1. Turn.
30th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K1. Break A.
Join D and proceed as follows:
Second Half: 1st row: SI1Pwyif. With D, K1. SI1Pwyif (see Diagram A). yb. Turn.


Bring yarn to front (yf). Slip next stitch purlwise (SI1P) and take yarn around this stitch to back of work (yb).

2nd and alt rows: SI1Pwyif (see Diagram B). yb. Knit to end of row.


Return the slipped stitch onto lefthand needle without working it. Turn work and purl the number of sts stated.

3rd row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K2 (see Diagram C). SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.


When knitting across all sts, pick up wrapped loop and place on lefthand needle. Knit tog with stitch being wrapped.

5th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K3. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
7th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K4. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
9th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K5. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
11th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K6. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
13th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K7. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
15th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K8. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
17th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K9. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
19th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K10. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
21st row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K11. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
23rd row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K12. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
25th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K13. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
27th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K14. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
29th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. K15. SI1Pwyif. yb. Turn.
30th row: SI1Pwyif. yb. Knit to end of row.**
Rep from ** to ** once more, substituting D for A and C for D.
***Next row: With C, SI1Pwyif. yb. Knit to last st. SI1. Pick up and knit next 'chain' along side edge of Rectangle. psso.

Next row: Knit.***
Rep last 2 rows to next corner.
Rep from ** to ** as given above to turn corner, substituting C for A and B for D .
Next row: With B, SI1Pwyif. yb. Knit to last st. SI1. Pick up and knit 1 st along bottom edge of Foundation Rectangle. psso.
Next row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows to next corner.
Rep from ** to ** as given above to turn corner, substituting B for A and E for D .
Work from ${ }^{* * *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$ as given above, substituting E for C . Cont as established, changing colors in the following sequence: A, D, C, B, E until Blanket measures approx $65^{\prime \prime}$ [ 165 cm ] total width, ending after having worked along one side edge. Cast off knitwise.
