## MATERIALS <br> Copper Coins (42014) <br> 

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket ${ }^{\text {Tm }} \mathbf{O}^{\mathbf{\prime}} \mathbf{G o}^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ )
4 O'Gos

Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) circular knitting needle 40 " $[101.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long or size needed to obtain gauge.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $50 \times 58$ " [127 x 147.5 cm ].

## GAUGE

8 sts and 13 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stocking st.
7 sts and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start knitting!

Cast on 96 sts. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 17 rows (garter st), noting first row is RS.
Next row: (WS). K3. *K2. Kfb. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3. 126 sts.
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: K10. Purl to last 10 sts. K10.
3rd row: K11. *SI1. K3, then psso over 3 knit sts. Rep from * to last 11 sts. K11.
4th row: K10. P1. *P3. yo. Rep from

* to last 11 sts. P1. K10.

Rep last 4 rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 53" [134.5 cm], ending on a 1 st row.
Next row: (WS). K3. *K2. K2tog.
Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3. 96 sts.
Knit 17 rows (garter st).
Cast off.
