



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

K = Knit

St(s) = Stitch(es)

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (Approx) 46" x 58"
[117 x 147.5 cm].

GAUGE

9 stitches (sts) and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Checkerboard Pattern (Pat).

INSTRUCTIONS

Checkerboard Pat (multiple of 10 + 4).

1st to 6th rows: Knit 2. *K5. Purl 5. Repeat (Rep) from * to last 2 sts. K2.

7th to 12th rows: K2. *P5. K5. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2. Rep 1st to 12th rows for Checkerboard Pat.

Cast on 104 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 3 rows (garter st), noting first row is Wrong Side (WS).

Proceed in Checkerboard Pat until work from beginning (beg) measures approx 57" [144 cm], ending on a 12th row of pat. Knit 3 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.3 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m) or (5.3 oz/150 g; 108 yds/98 m)

Olive (10241) or Pine Bough (86242) **5 (9) balls or 910 yds/827 m**

Size U.S. 13 (9 mm) Susan Bates® circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® yarn needle.
